Ear Mite & Tick Control to be used as an aid in eliminating mites and ticks in the ears of cats and dogs and for the relief from itching caused by such conditions. Apply 5 drops into the ears twice daily until ticks and mites are eliminated. Do not allow children to apply this product. Use other EPA approved products for treatment of mites and ticks outside the ear.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION

HUMAN: Harmful if swallowed, absorbed through the skin, or inhaled. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Avoid breathing vapor or spray mist. Causes moderate eye irritation. If swallowed	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. • Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. • Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by the poison control center or doctor. • Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.
If on skin or clothing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Take off contaminated clothing. • Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15 – 20 minutes.
If inhaled	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Move person to fresh air. • If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible.
