DIRECTIONS FOR USE OF HOSE-END SPRAYER CAP:

The enclosed hose-end sprayer cap is calibrated to deliver the correct amount of Adams Yard Spray. Use this cap ONLY with the accompanying bottle of lawn spray in accordance with carton label directions.

TO USE HOSE-END SPRAYER CAP

1. Check that valve is in OFF position.
2. Screw garden hose into back of spray cap (Note: end with black rubber washer).
3. Remove bottle cap from Adams Yard Spray and save for storage after use.
4. Insert small end of dip tube into lawn spray bottle.
5. Screw lawn spray bottle counter clockwise into sprayer cap until tight.
6. Turn on water at faucet.
7. TO START FLOW OF INSECTICIDE, turn valve to ON position (see 1. above).
8. Spray evenly and completely over lawn and other infested areas giving particular attention to areas frequented by pets.
9. TO STOP FLOW OF INSECTICIDE at any time, simply turn valve to OFF position.

To store remaining insecticides, turn water off at faucet and remove insecticide bottle from sprayer. Leave dip tube in bottle and replace cap. Rinse off sprayer and store in accompanying box.
