

**SHAKE WELL BEFORE USE**

**FOR USE ON CATS AND KITTENS OVER 12 WEEKS OF AGE TO KILL FLEAS AND TICKS:** Hold the container upright. Spray at a distance of 8 to 12 inches. Spray over entire haircoat making sure the coat is thoroughly wetted to the skin. As you spray, fluff the hair so the spray will penetrate to the skin. Make sure spray wets ticks thoroughly. Spray against the lay of the hair, roughing the hair on long-haired cats. Weight of cat, length of hair and density of coat will determine amount of spray to be applied to wet the skin. This 8 oz. bottle should be sufficient for 10 applications to a 10 lb. cat. Do not spray into eyes, face or genitalia. When applied at the label dose rate, the cat should not be retreated more frequently than once every 14 days. Lighter applications will reduce period of effectiveness, may result in earlier reinfestation and may require more frequent retreatment. For best results in controlling ticks, spray directly on the tick. Allow cat to air dry or blow dry. Do not towel dry. This product is formulated to leave the hair coat soft and manageable for grooming. Do not reapply more often than once every 14 days.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**

**PESTICIDE STORAGE:** Store in original container in a cool, dry place inaccessible to children and pets and away from heat and open flame.

**CONTAINER DISPOSAL:** If Empty: Nonrefillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. Offer for recycling if available. If Partly filled: Call your local solid waste agency for disposal instructions. Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain.
