SHAKE WELL BEFORE USE:

1. Hold bottle upright about 6 inches from pet.
2. Spray lightly until the tips of the pet's hair are moist. Keep spray out of pet's eyes.
3. Rub spray into animal's coat. For longhaired cats ruffle fur to allow the spray to reach skin.
4. After 10 minutes, dry cat with towel.
5. Comb and brush coat.
6. Repeat once a week.
7. If you see a tick, spray it directly.
8. Use on bedding and other areas as needed.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: Storage: If empty: Do not reuse this container. Place in trash or offer for recycling if available.

If partly filled: Call your solid waste agency for disposal instructions. Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain.



If signs of sensitivity occur, bathe your pet with mild soap and rinse with large amounts of water. If signs continue, consult a veterinarian immediately.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS: This product is toxic to aquatic invertebrates. Using it in a manner other than that described by this label could result in harm to aquatic invertebrates.

FIRST AID:

Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes; then continue rinsing eye. Call a Poison Control Center or doctor for treatment advice. Have the product container or label with you when calling a Poison Control Center or doctor, or going for treatment. You may also contact 1-800-275-1414 for emergency medical treatment information.

NOTE TO PHYSICIANS AND VETERINARIANS:

This product contains tetrachlorvinphos (an organophosphate), which is a cholinesterase inhibitor. Cholinergic symptoms may include salivation, miosis, incoordination, muscle fasciculation and/or weakness, vomiting and diarrhea. Atropine is antidotal. 2-PAM may be effective as an adjunct to atropine. Call a Poison Control Center for further information.
