SHAKE WELL BEFORE USE

1. Hold bottle upright about 6 inches from pet.
2. Spray lightly until the tips of the pet's hair are moist.
Keep spray out of pet's eyes.
3. Rub spray into animal's coat. For longhaired dogs ruffle fur to allow the spray to reach skin.
4. After 10 minutes, dry dog with towel.
5. Comb and brush coat.
6. Repeat once a week.
7. If you see a tick, spray it directly.
8. Use on bedding and other areas as needed.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:

Storage:

If empty: Do not reuse this container. Place in trash or offer for recycling if available.

If partly filled: Call your solid waste agency for disposal instructions.
Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain.
