FIRST AID

Directions for Use
It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner other than which it was indicated.

Treating the spa or hot tub:
Important - BaquaSpa Sanitizer is incompatible with chlorinating and brominating chemical products.

Start Up with BaquaSpa Sanitizer:

1. Remove chlorine or bromine source and disconnect feeder.
2. Drain existing water in spa and clean spa surface and filter.
3. Fill spa with water and have your Authorized Dealer of BaquaSpa Sanitizer check your water for proper water balance.
4. After water has been balanced, add BaquaSpa Sanitizer to give a concentration of 50 ppm (.67 oz. of product per 100 gallons of spa water).
5. Circulate water 15 minutes, then check BaquaSpa Sanitizer concentration with BaquaSpa Test Strips and adjust if necessary.

Normal Spa Maintenance:

1. Every week, check BaquaSpa Sanitizer concentration and pH. Adjust if necessary.
2. The level of BaquaSpa Sanitizer should be maintained between 30 and 50 ppm. When the level of BaquaSpa Sanitizer is 30 ppm or less, add enough BaquaSpa Sanitizer to bring the level up to 50 ppm. To raise the BaquaSpa Sanitizer level 10 ppm, add 0.25 oz. per 100 gallons of spa water.

PROBLEM SOLVING AND SUPPLEMENTAL POOL INFORMATION
Please remember that BaquaSpa Sanitizer and chlorine-based chemicals are not compatible. If you accidentally add chlorine to your spa, refer to the BaquaSpa Pool Care Guide for troubleshooting techniques.

Do not use BaquaSpa Sanitizer in spas previously exposed to metals that may cause staining (see BaquaSpa Pool Care Guide for specific information). Do not use in free standing spas or hot tubs. BaquaSpa Sanitizer is not compatible with many detergents and some alginates (such as those based on copper). Always check with your Authorized Dealer for compatibility before adding a product that isn't labeled BaquaSpa. If algae, cloudiness or spa problems develop consult your Authorized BaquaSpa Dealer.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL
Pesticide Disposal
Keep container closed when not in use. Store in original container in an area inaccessible to children.

Protect From Freezing
In case of a leak or spill, soak up with absorbent, such as sand, earth, or sawdust, and shovel into waste container. Remove waste to chemical waste area, and dispose of in accordance with local pollution regulations.
To dispose of excess product, securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL
Do not reuse container. To dispose of empty container, rinse thoroughly before discarding in trash.
