This product gives the effectiveness of chlorine without the chlorine odor. Take a sample of spa water to your authorized dealer regularly for a detailed analysis.

Start Up: To start up a new spa or one recently drained, clean all surfaces, back flush or clean the filter, chemically balance the calcium hardness and total alkalinity, treat for iron, copper and manganese, if present. Adjust the pH to 7.2-7.8, prior to initiating treatment with this product.

Adjust the Mermaid by Brilliance for spas Sanitizer Dispenser according to the manufacturer's directions to maintain an active bromine level between 2-4 ppm in residential spas and 3-6 ppm in commercial spas. Maintenance of residual is dependent on water temperature, light intensity and bather load, and requires frequent checks with a test kit. Use a reliable test method for the bromine measurements. The pump and filter should be operated at least three hours every day regardless of use. Replace the Mermaid by Brilliance for spas Sanitizer Dispenser when empty.


