WHY YOU SHOULD USE THIS PRODUCT: Pace® POWER Algaecide is a long-lasting algaecide. With one treatment, this product will prevent algae growth in your swimming pool for three months. Your pool water will sparkle as never before.

IMPORTANT NOTE: Always apply chemicals separately. Never combine them.

APPLICATION: This product comes concentrated. Carefully pour required amount of Pace® POWER Algaecide into the pool while maintaining continuous pool circulation. It is best to distribute the required amount by pouring slowly around the edge of the pool. Avoid concentrating the application in only one spot.

Apply under sunny conditions for most effective results.

GENERAL DIRECTIONS:

22 OZ

1. Maintain pool water in the pH range 7.2 to 7.6. Adjust pH to 7.2 for severe algae.
2. Ensure that filtration system is working properly and that filtration cycle is adequate.
3. A regular brushing program will assist in the removal of stubborn algae.

20 OZ

4. Calculate the volume of Pace® POWER Algaecide required for your pool.
5. Add this product directly to the pool, distributing over as wide an area as possible.

6. While this product controls algae it is important that adequate levels of sanitizer (chlorine) be maintained to control bacterial growth.

INITIAL POOL START-UP: Use a sequestering agent product to prevent scale and stain formation.

PREVENTIVE- Add 16 fl. oz. of this product per 10,000 gallons of pool water every three months to prevent algae growth in all pool types.


