Treatment Areas	Target Pest	Remarks	Use Rate
Spot Treatment	Ants	Water lightly after application.	Apply 1½ teaspoons over and around each ant hill.
	Fire Ants	Immediately after application, water in thoroughly. A minimum of 1 gallon of water should be applied to each mound area. Apply gently to avoid disturbing ants. Use of high pressure watering equipment may disturb the ants and cause migration, reducing product effectiveness. Note: For best results, apply in cool weather, 65° - 80°F, or in early morning or late evening hours. Treat new mounds as they appear.	Apply 1 cup over and 2 ft. around each fire ant mound.

BAND TREATMENT AROUND HOUSE

- Gordon's Ant Granules kills ants, as well as fleas, brown dog ticks, clover mites, crickets, earwigs, millipedes, roaches, sowbugs (pillbugs), spiders, silverfish and other pests.
- Break the seal and open the pop-top cap.
- Evenly sprinkle granules in a 3 to 5 foot wide band along the foundation of your home. Use rate = 3.2 oz. for each 100 sq. ft. area (5' x 20').
- Gently water treated areas.

USE TIPS

- Try to get even coverage throughout your "barrier band".
- Reapply after hard rains to areas where down spouts empty.



FIRST AID
