

HOW THIS PRODUCT WORKS

Green Light Wipe-Out® Tough Weed Killer for Lawns provides post-emergence control of annual, biennial and perennial broadleaf weeds in established home lawns.

General Use Precautions and Restrictions

Do not apply more than 1.2 lb. of Green Light Wipe-Out® Tough Weed Killer for Lawns per 1,000 sq. ft. per application to perennial ryegrass and tall fescue unless some injury can be tolerated.

Do not apply Green Light Wipe-Out® Tough Weed Killer for Lawns directly to, or otherwise permit Green Light Wipe-Out® Tough Weed Killer for Lawns to come into contact with flowers, ornamental shrubs or trees, or other desirable broadleaf plants, as serious plant injury may occur.

Do not collect grass clippings for use as mulch around plants.

To minimize the potential for grass injury, additional applications should not be made within four weeks of a previous application.

Avoid unnecessary disturbances, including watering and mowing, for approximately 24 hours after application.

Do not apply more than 3.4 lb. of Green Light Wipe-Out® Tough Weed Killer for Lawns per 1,000 sq. ft. per application or more than 5.1 lb. of Green Light Wipe-Out® Tough Weed Killer for Lawns per 1,000 sq. ft. per annual growing season.

Treatment on Turfgrass Species Not Listed on the Label Green Light Wipe-Out® Tough Weed Killer for Lawns

Users who wish to use Green Light Wipe-Out® Tough Weed Killer for Lawns on turf species not recommended on this label may determine the suitability for use by treating a small area at a recommended rate. Prior to treatment of larger areas, the treated area should be observed for any sign of herbicidal injury during 30 days of normal growing conditions to determine if the target turfgrass species is tolerant. Applications should not be made to turfgrass under stress. The user assumes responsibility for any plant damage or other liability resulting from use of Green Light Wipe-Out® Tough Weed Killer for Lawns on turfgrass species not recommended on this label.

Green Light Wipe-Out® Tough Weed Killer for Lawns is recommended for use on the following established turfgrass species (numbers in parentheses (-) refer to footnotes below):

(1) Use no more than 2.3 lb. of Green Light Wipe-Out® Tough Weed Killer for Lawns per 1,000 sq. ft. per application.

(2) Use Green Light Wipe-Out® Tough Weed Killer for Lawns on these species at a maximum rate of 1.2 lb. per 1,000 sq. ft. per application and only if some injury can be tolerated. A slight yellowing of turfgrass may occur within two weeks of application. The discoloration is transient and is generally gone within four weeks of treatment under adequate growing conditions.

(3) Use no more than 3.4 lb. of Green Light Wipe-Out® Tough Weed Killer for Lawns per 1,000 sq. ft. per application.

Weeds Controlled or Suppressed

Generally, application rates at the lower end of the recommended rate range will be satisfactory for young, succulent growth of sensitive weed species. For less sensitive species and under conditions where control is more difficult (plant stress conditions such as drought or extreme temperatures, dense weed stands and/or larger weeds), the higher rate within the rate range or repeat applications will be needed. Weeds growing in the absence of competition from other vegetation generally require higher rates or repeat applications to obtain satisfactory control or suppression.

HOW TO APPLY

Apply Green Light Wipe-Out® Tough Weed Killer for Lawns using a drop or rotary-type spreader designed to apply granular herbicides. Calibrate application equipment prior to use according to manufacturer's directions. Check frequently to be sure equipment is working properly and distributing granules uniformly. Do not use spreaders that apply material in narrow concentrated bands. Avoid skips or overlaps as poor weed control or turfgrass injury may occur. More uniform application may be achieved by spreading half of the required amount of product over the area and then applying the remaining half in swaths at right angles to the first.

Mow the turfgrass two to three days before applying Green Light Wipe-Out® Tough Weed Killer for Lawns. If the turfgrass is under moisture stress, a thorough sprinkler irrigation of at least 1/2 inch is necessary at least one to two days before application. Apply Green Light Wipe-Out® Tough Weed Killer for Lawns in the morning when dew is present. If necessary, sprinkler irrigate with less than 1/4 inch of water just prior to application to maximize particle adherence to leaf surfaces. Avoid watering of treated area within 24 hours of application. Avoid making applications if rainfall is expected within 24 hours after treatment.

Application Techniques for Applying Green Light Wipe-Out® Tough Weed Killer for Lawns

When using a drop-type spreader, a splashboard mounted under the hopper will provide more even granule distribution. A chain fastened to the side of the spreader and allowed to drag on the soil surface can be used to mark the edge of the treated swath and help prevent skips or overlaps.

For treating smaller areas, a hand held or push-type rotary applicator such as a whirlybird or cyclone unit is recommended. For hand held units, walk and turn the crank at a constant rate of speed.

A shake-type applicator made from a small container with holes punched in the bottom is recommended for small, difficult to treat areas. Carefully measure the amount of product needed to avoid over application.

Spreader Settings as a Guide for Calibration

Note: These settings are provided as a suggested starting point in calibrating each individual spreader. Since no two spreaders are alike, these settings are not intended to be used as absolute recommendations by Green Light Company or the spreader manufacturer.

HOW MUCH TO APPLY

Apply 1.2 to 3.4 lb. of Green Light Wipe-Out® Tough Weed Killer for Lawns per 1,000 sq. ft. to established turfgrass. Sequential or follow-up applications may be required for dense weed infestations. Also, adverse environmental conditions prior to or after application may reduce effectiveness. If required, additional applications can be made every 30 days.

WHEN TO APPLY

Best weed control results are obtained when Green Light Wipe-Out® Tough Weed Killer for Lawns is applied to small, actively growing weeds in the spring or early fall. Extreme growing conditions such as drought or near freezing temperatures prior to, at, or following time of application may reduce weed control. Broadleaf weed species germinate at different times.

Apply Green Light Wipe-Out® Tough Weed Killer for Lawns to newly seeded cool season turfgrass only after the third mowing or after the turfgrass seedlings have tillered and developed an adequate secondary root system. Reseeding is not recommended for at least three to four weeks after application.
