STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT:

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with it's labeling.

SWIMMING POOLS AND OUTDOOR SPAS

This product should be added along pool edges while filter and pump are in operation. To provide time for even distribution in the pool water, bathers should wait a minimum of 15 minutes after this product addition before entering the pool.

For pools and spas with visible algae, add 14 fluid ounces of this product for every 10,000 gallons of water (5 ppm active quaternary). After 24 hours, remove dead algae by cleaning. If algae is still present, repeat dosage as necessary.

For initial treatment of clean pools and spas, add 5 to 8 fluid ounces of this product for every 10,000 gallons of water (2 to 3 ppm active quaternary). Maintenance additions of 2 to 3 fluid ounces per 10,000 gallons (0.5 to 1 ppm active quaternary) should be added every 7 days, or more frequently depending on water and use factors. A booster dose of 2 fluid ounces per 10,000 gallons (0.5 ppm active quaternary) should be provided after each rain.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

DANGER: Corrosive. Causes irreversible eye damage and skin burns. May be fatal if swallowed. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Wear safety glasses when applying.
