

DIRECTIONS FOR USE
It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Read all directions before using this product.
Remove towelette and unfold fully. For maximum protection, wipe evenly and completely over all exposed skin. Do not apply near eyes and mouth, and apply sparingly around ears. Each towelette will cover the face and arms or an equivalent size area. Apply only to exposed skin and/or clothing, do not use under clothing.
Never apply over cuts, wounds, or irritated skin. Do not allow children to handle this product, and do not apply to children's hands. When using on children, apply to your own hands first and then apply it to the child. Avoid overexposure; frequent reapplication and saturation are unnecessary. Use just enough repellent to cover exposed skin. Wash hands after treatment to avoid incidental contact. After returning indoors, wash treated skin with soap and water or bathe. Remove and wash treated clothing before wearing it again.
For ticks and chiggers, also apply liberally to shoe tops, socks and around openings of clothing. Do not apply on or near acetate, rayon, spandex or other synthetics other than nylon, furniture plastics, leather, watch crystals and painted or varnished surfaces including automobiles.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS
Hazards To Humans & Domestic Animals
WARNING. Flammable liquid and vapor. Causes eye irritation. May be harmful if swallowed. Avoid contact with eyes and lips. Do not apply to excessively sunburned or damaged skin. May cause skin reaction in rare cases. If you suspect a reaction to this product discontinue use, wash treated skin, and call your local poison control center.

FIRST AID
IF IN EYES - Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye.
