**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Use 1.00 fluid oz. (2 tablespoons) of this product per 100 lbs. of fabric (dry weight). Use a maximum of 60 gallons (500 lbs.) of water per 100 lbs. of fabric (dry weight).

To soften laundered fabrics and obtain residual bacteriostatic activity against gram negative and / or gram positive odor-causing bacteria, dilute the appropriate amount of this product in one to two gallons of water and then add to the wash-wheel at the beginning of the final rinse cycle.

Repeat the treatment of fabric with this product after each washing.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**

Store in original container in areas inaccessible to children. Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash.

**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS**

**HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS**

**DANGER:** Corrosive. Causes irreversible eye damage and skin burns. Wear goggles or face shield and protective gloves (rubber, chemical resistant) when handling.
