This product is recommended for disinfecting hard, nonporous, surfaces. Delivers non-acid disinfectant and cleaning performance. Effective against the pathogenic fungi *Trichophyton mentagrophytes* (Athlete's Foot Fungus) when used as directed for disinfection with a contact time of 10 minutes on hard, nonporous surfaces in bathrooms, including shower stalls, floors, bath mats, glazed bathroom tiles and locker room benches. Cleans, disinfects and deodorizes in one labor saving step. Is formulated for use in daily maintenance programs with a balance of detergents, biocides and malodor counteractants that deliver effective cleaning, disinfecting and malodor control.

BATHROOM: Great for cleaning and deodorizing baths, tubs and glazed tiles. Leaves everything bright and clean, kills odor-causing bacteria. Odors disappear instantly. Use where odors are a problem.

This product is a one-step disinfectant, Bactericidal according to the current AOAC Use-Dilution Test Method, Fungicidal according to the AOAC Fungicidal Test and Virucidal* according to the virucidal qualification modified in the presence of 5% organic serum against: (Bacteria) *Pseudomonas aeruginosa*, *Staphylococcus aureus*, *Salmonella choleraesuis*, *Streptococcus pyogenes* (Viruses): *Herpes Simplex Virus Type 2, *HIV-1 (the AIDS virus), *Influenza Type A/Brazil (Fungi): *Aspergillus niger*, *Trichophyton mentagrophytes*

Use this product in: Bathrooms, kitchens, dental offices, health care Facilities, hospitals, medical offices, nursing homes, day care centers, airports, athletic facilities, hotels, institutional facilities, locker rooms, motels, public rest rooms, schools, and shower and bath areas. Use this product on washable hard, nonporous surfaces of bathroom fixtures, bathtubs, cabinets, coils and drain pans of air conditioning and refrigeration equipment and heat pumps, countertops, fiberglass bathtubs, fiberglass sinks, showers, sinks, toilets, glazed tiles, urinals, walls and other nonporous surfaces made of glazed ceramic, glazed porcelain, metal, plastic (such as polystyrene or polypropylene), stainless steel, upholstery, vinyl and plastic.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. This product is not for use on medical device surfaces.

DISINFECTION*/VIRUCIDAL/FUNGICIDAL/MOLD & MILDEW DIRECTIONS: If surfaces are visibly dirty preclean first. Apply this product with a mop, sponge, cloth or sprayer on hard, nonporous surfaces to thoroughly wet surfaces. For sprayer applications use a coarse spray device. Spray 6-8 inches from the surface. Avoid breathing spray. Rub with a brush, sponge or cloth. Treated surfaces must remain wet for 10 minutes. Wipe dry with a clean cloth, or sponge or allow to air dry. Rinsing is not necessary on floor surfaces that are to be waxed or polished. For mold and mildew growth, repeat application weekly or when growth reappears. Rinse all surfaces that come in contact with food such as countertops, appliances, tables and stovetops with potable water before reuse. This product should not be used to clean utensils, glassware and dishes.

TO CLEAN AND/OR DEODORIZE: Apply by mop, sponge, cloth or spray on hard, nonporous surfaces. Wipe dry with a clean cloth, or sponge, or allow to air dry.

TO CLEAN AND DISINFECT TOILET BOWLS AND URINALS: Remove gross filth from bowl. Remove or expel over the inner trap residual bowl water. Use 4 ounces of product in toilet bowl or urinal. Apply directly around bowl and under rim; then brush or swab thoroughly. Allow product to remain on surface for a contact time of 10 minutes; then flush toilet. This product, when used as directed, will not harm white or colored bowls or inanimate, hard surfaces. Close cap on container after use.

Contact Time: Effective against HIV-1 (AIDS virus) on hard, nonporous surfaces in the presence of a moderate amount of organic soil for a contact time of 5 minutes at room temperature. Use a 10 minute contact time for disinfection against all other bacteria, fungi and viruses claimed.

DISPOSAL OF INFECTIOUS MATERIALS: Blood and other body fluids should be autoclaved and disposed of according to federal, state and local regulations for infectious waste disposal.
