HAZARDS TO HUMANS & DOMESTIC ANIMALS

FIRST AID

Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice. Have the product container or label with you when calling a poison control center or doctor, or going for treatment.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Zep Meter Mist Air Sanitizer III is an effective formulation specially designed for use in the timed, intermittent aerosol dispensing unit for the reduction of air-borne bacteria which can cause undesirable odors. Recommended for use in lobbies, reception rooms, locker rooms, rest rooms of hospitals, theaters or shops.

For Metered Application: Remove cap from can and place in metered aerosol dispenser with spray head beneath actuator, nozzle facing front. Factors such as air currents, temperature, humidity and conformation of treated area govern number of units required for effective control. One unit should normally treat 6,000 cubic feet of closed air space. Dispenser location should be at a height of 7-8 feet and directed compatibly to air currents in closed areas. One can, used on a 24-hour basis, will provide adequate air sanitizing.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

STORAGE: Store in a cool area away from heat or open flame.
