

## INSECTICIDE EAR TAGS



*For up to 5 months' control of Horn flies and Face flies. Use two tags per head on beef and non-lactating dairy cattle and calves.*

**ACTIVE INGREDIENTS:**

## PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

### CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through the skin. Avoid contact with skin, eyes, or clothing. Wear rubber or nonpermeable protective gloves when applying or removing tags. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, or using tobacco. Certain individuals are known to have a special sensitivity to some pyrethroid insecticides. Such individuals on contact with the insecticide may experience a "tingling or burning" sensation around the face, arms, armpits, and/or groin. If such sensitivity occurs, wash the affected area with mild soap and water; to relieve the sensation, apply a thin layer of an oil-based ointment. The sensation generally dissipates within 18-24 hours. If not, call a physician.

### FIRST AID

If on skin or clothing:	• Take off contaminated clothing.	• Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.
	• Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes.	
If swallowed:	• Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice.	• Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by the poison control center or doctor.
	• Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow.

**NOTE TO PHYSICIAN:** This product contains a cholinesterase inhibitor. If symptoms of cholinesterase inhibition are present, atropine sulfate by injection is antidotal.

### ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is toxic to fish. Do not add directly to water. Do not contaminate water by disposal of used tags. Use this product only as specified on the label.

### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. This labeling must be in the possession of the user at the time of pesticide application.

For optimum control and to minimize development of insect resistance, use two tags per animal (one in each ear). All animals in the herd should be tagged. Apply when flies first appear in spring. Replace as necessary. Apply with ALLFLEX® Tagging System. Tags remain effective up to 5 months. Remove tags in fall.

### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

**Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.**

**Storage:** Store in cool place away from direct sunlight. Opened pouches containing ear tags should be resealed for storage.

**Pesticide Disposal:** Remove tags before slaughter. Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

**Container Disposal:** Dispose of empty bag in a sanitary landfill or by incineration or, if allowed by State and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.
