

## INSECT REPELLENT

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE:** It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

**Read all Directions and Precautions on this Product Label prior to use.** Hold 4 to 6 inches from skin while spraying keeping nozzle pointed away from face. Do not inhale. Do not spray directly on face or enclosed areas. To apply to face, spray on hands and rub on. Slightly moisten with a slow sweeping motion. Excessive amounts or frequent reapplication is unnecessary. Do not apply to the hands of small children. Repels mosquitoes and ticks for up to eight hours. Reapply every 8 hours. Do not exceed two applications per day. Avoid contact with lips, cuts, wounds, or irritated skin. Do not apply to excessively sunburned skin. Do not spray directly on face. Do not apply under clothing. Apply sparingly around ears.

**STORAGE & DISPOSAL:** Store in a cool, dry place out of the reach of children. Keep away from heat, sparks and open flame. **IF EMPTY:** Do not reuse this container.
