

DIRECTIONS FOR USE (CONTINUED)
 Apply with a cloth, sponge, mop, coarse trigger sprayer, or by soaking. Eating utensils and drinking glasses must be sanitized by immersion. Thoroughly wet all surfaces. Drain thoroughly and air dry. Do not rinse. Fresh sanitizing solution must be prepared at least daily or more often if the use solution becomes diluted. For mechanical applications, use solution may not be reused for sanitizing applications but may be reused for other purposes such as cleaning. Before use as a sanitizer in federally inspected meat and poultry plants and dairies, food products and packaging materials must be removed from the room or carefully protected.
