**SPECIFIC INSTRUCTIONS  
SEWER TREATMENT - ROOT DESTROYER**

**ROOT CONTROL GENERAL INFORMATION:** Plant roots can penetrate through small cracks and poorly sealed joints of sewer lines. These small, roots will continue to grow larger causing breakage, reduced flow and flow stoppage. Copper sulfate has been known to be an effective means to control roots in residential sewers.

**RESIDENTIAL SEWER SYSTEMS:** When a reduced water flow is first noticed, and root growth is thought to be the cause, treat with product. It is important not to wait until a stoppage occurs because some water flow is necessary to move copper sulfate to the area of the root growth. Usually, within 4 days, after roots have accumulated sufficient copper sulfate the roots will die and begin to decay and water flow should increase. As the roots regrow, follow-up treatments with copper sulfate will be required. Applications may be made each year in the spring after plant growth begins and during late summer or early fall. The minimum retreatment interval is 6 months.

Apply 1 pound of product two times a year to household sewers. Add product to sewer lines by pouring about 1/2 pound increments into the toilet bowl nearest the sewer line and flush, or remove cleanout plug and pour entire labeled quantity directly into the sewer line. Replace the plug and flush the toilet several times.

**ROOT CONTROL IN SEPTIC TANK AND LEACH LINE PIPES:**

**SEPTIC TANK** - The majority of copper sulfate will settle in the septic tank itself and little will pass into the leach lines.

**LEACH LINE PIPES** - Add 1 pound of product to the distribution box located between the septic tank and the leach lines. A cleanout plug opening may need to be installed if the distribution box does not have an opening leading to the leach lines.

\*NOTE: Do not use as a sewer additive where prohibited by State law. State law prohibits the use of this product in sewage systems in the State of Connecticut. Not for sale or use in the California counties of Alameda, Contra Costa, Marin, Napa, San Francisco, San Mateo, Santa Clara, Solano and Sonoma for root control in sewers.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**


Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

**PESTICIDE STORAGE:** Store in original container and place in a locked storage area.

**PESTICIDE DISPOSAL:** Call your local solid waste agency for disposal instructions (1-800-CLEANUP). Unless otherwise instructed, place in the trash. Never pour unused product down the drain or on the ground.

**CONTAINER HANDLING:** Nonrefillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container.

If empty: Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. If partly filled: Call your local solid waste agency for disposal instructions. Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain.
