NOTE: 1 level tsp of Marathon 1% Granular = 4.1 grams

Application can be made at transplanting, repotting, or on existing plants. Irrigate after application to move the active ingredient into the root zone. Do not apply more irrigation water than is required to saturate the potting media.

Method of Application: For the purpose of this Special Local Need (SLN), Marathon 1% Granular will be applied manually into containerized plants. Personal Protective equipment (PPE) must be worn as specified on the product label.

Timing of Application: 2 applications per crop with minimum 6 weeks between applications.

Restricted Entry Interval (REI): 12 hours

Pre-harvest Interval (PHI): Not applicable

Additional Requirements:

(1) Treated seed crops shall spend the entire life cycle, within a greenhouse, lath or shade house. In addition, use is limited only to seed crops listed on this label that are used within the context of a plant breeding program.

(2) Seed and plant material from treated plants shall not be used for food or feed.

(3) If treated plant material and potting media are discarded on-site via soil incorporation into a research field, a 12-month plant-back interval **must** be observed for crops not listed on an imidacloprid label, or for crops for which no tolerances for the active ingredient have been established.
