**DCAB UPDATES “HAWAII TRAVELER TIPS”**  
**A RESOURCE FOR VISITORS WHO HAVE DISABILITIES**  
**OR HEALTH CONDITIONS**

HONOLULU – The state's Disability and Communication Access Board (DCAB) has updated its “Hawaii Traveler Tips” informational guide for the islands of O’ahu, Hawaii, Kaua’i, Maui, and Moloka’i. The guide contains extensive information on resources for visitors to the islands who have disabilities or health conditions.

Traveler tips include general accessibility information about our airports, options for obtaining accessible transportation, a listing of home medical supply companies, and other support service resources. Contact information for the Hawaii Department of Agriculture for information on requirements for allowing guide dogs and service animals to enter Hawaii without quarantine is also included.
