

**NOTICE OF PROPOSED WATER POLLUTION CONTROL PERMIT
FOR KALOKO LIGHT INDUSTRIAL SUBDIVISION, PHASE III
ON-SITE CONSTRUCTION AND OFF-SITE TRAFFIC IMPROVEMENTS
NORTH-KONA, HAWAII**

The State Department of Health (DOH), tentatively proposes to issue a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit to discharge storm water runoff from the Kaloko Industrial Subdivision, Phase IV, On-Site Clearing to receiving State waters, subject to special conditions to:

TSA CORPORATION

The proposed draft permit will expire five (5) years from the date of issuance.

The project is located on the south side of existing Hina Lani Street, approximately 1000 feet east of the Hina Lani and Kamanu Street intersection, Kaloko, Kona, Hawaii, TMK: (3) 7-3-051:060. The proposed project is for clearing of vegetation (no grubbing) for topographic surveying and soil investigation. The project involves on-site clearing of approximately 58 acres to take advantage of the equipment currently available on-site.

Storm water runoff from the project will be subject to Best Management Practices prior to being discharged to the receiving State water, the Pacific Ocean at Kaloko Point, a Class AA, Marine Water, at the discharge point coordinates: Latitude 19°41'04.28"N and Longitude 156°02'04.66"W.

The receiving water is classified by the DOH as Class AA, Marine Waters. The objective of Class AA waters is for these waters to remain in their natural pristine state as nearly as possible with an absolute minimum of pollution or alteration of water quality from any human-caused source or actions. To the extent possible, the wilderness character of these areas shall be protected.

Persons wishing to comment upon or object to the proposed NPDES permit or to request a public hearing, should submit their comments or requests in writing no later than 30 calendar days after the date of this notice, either in person or by mail, to:

All written comments and requests received on time will be considered. If DOH determines that there is significant public interest, a public hearing may be held after at least 30 calendar days of public notice.

If DOH's position is substantially unchanged after considering all timely written comments and all oral comments at any public hearing that may be held, then the DOH will issue the NPDES permit and this action will be final.
