COURSE DESCRIPTION:

This program consists of four videotapes and related textbooks. Videotape #1 - Fire Safety covers types of fires and the most effective extinguishing techniques and equipment are explained in this unit. Videotape #2 - Hazardous Substances covers dangerous or toxic substances found in the plant and the safety equipment necessary for mitigating these effects. Videotape #3 - Personal Safety covers various plant hazards (electrical, eye, machinery, etc.) And personal safety equipment (hard hats, safety shoes, eye wear). And videotape #4 - Respiratory Protection describes various types of respiratory hazards (particulates, gasses, oxygen deficiency) and respiratory protection gear.
