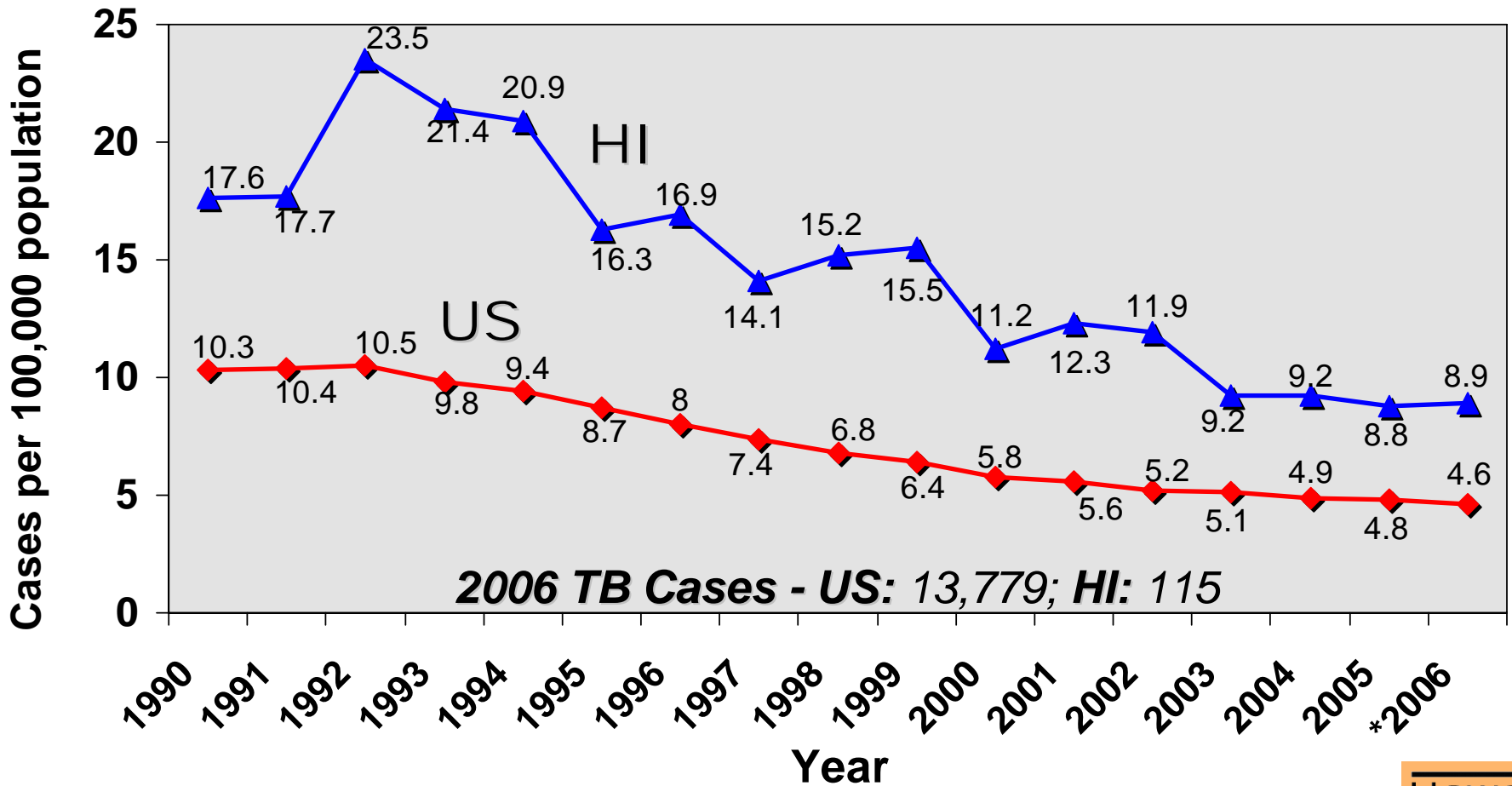

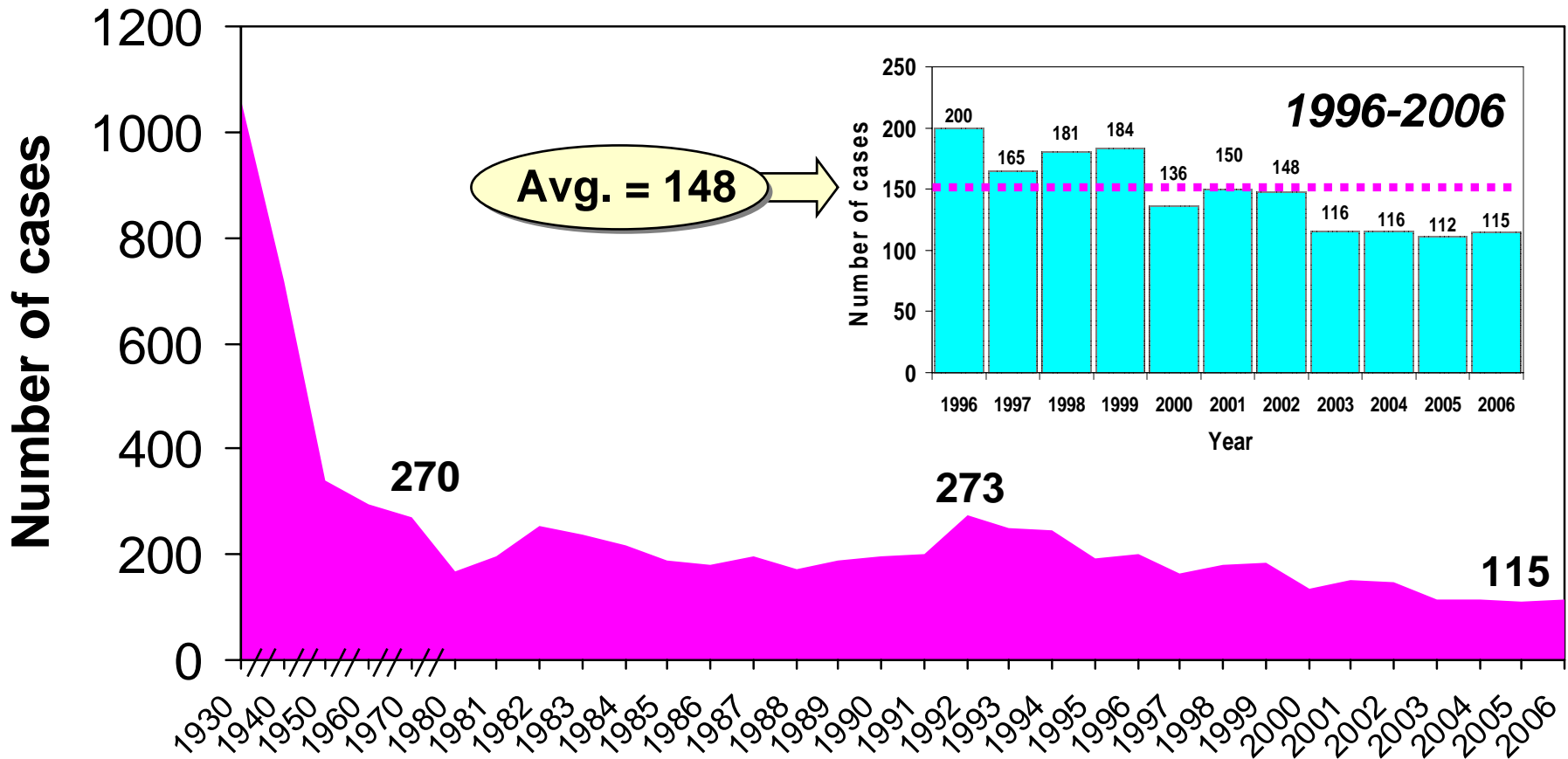
## Hawai`i vs. US, 1990 - 2006

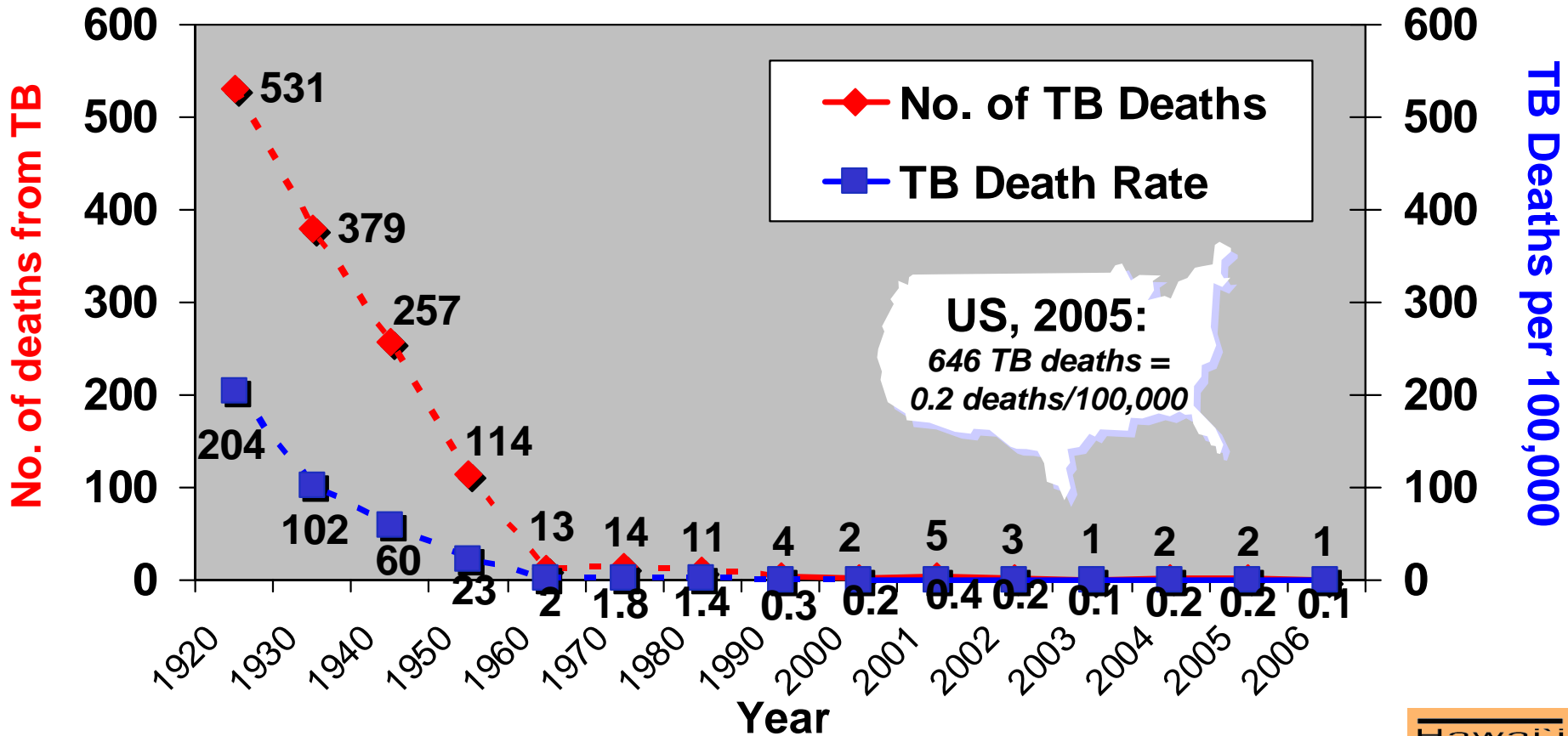

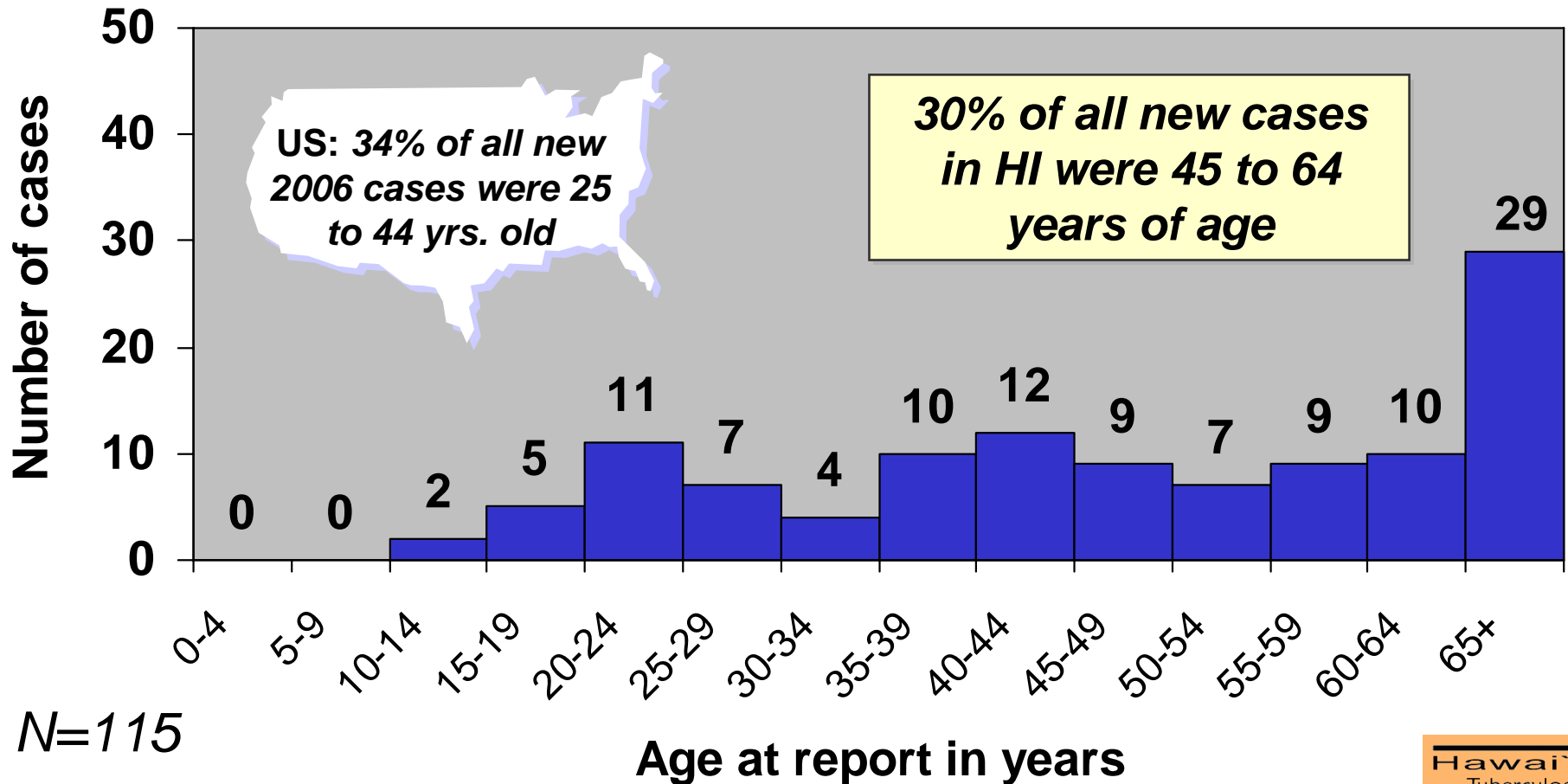

# TB Cases by Age at Diagnosis Hawai`i, 2006



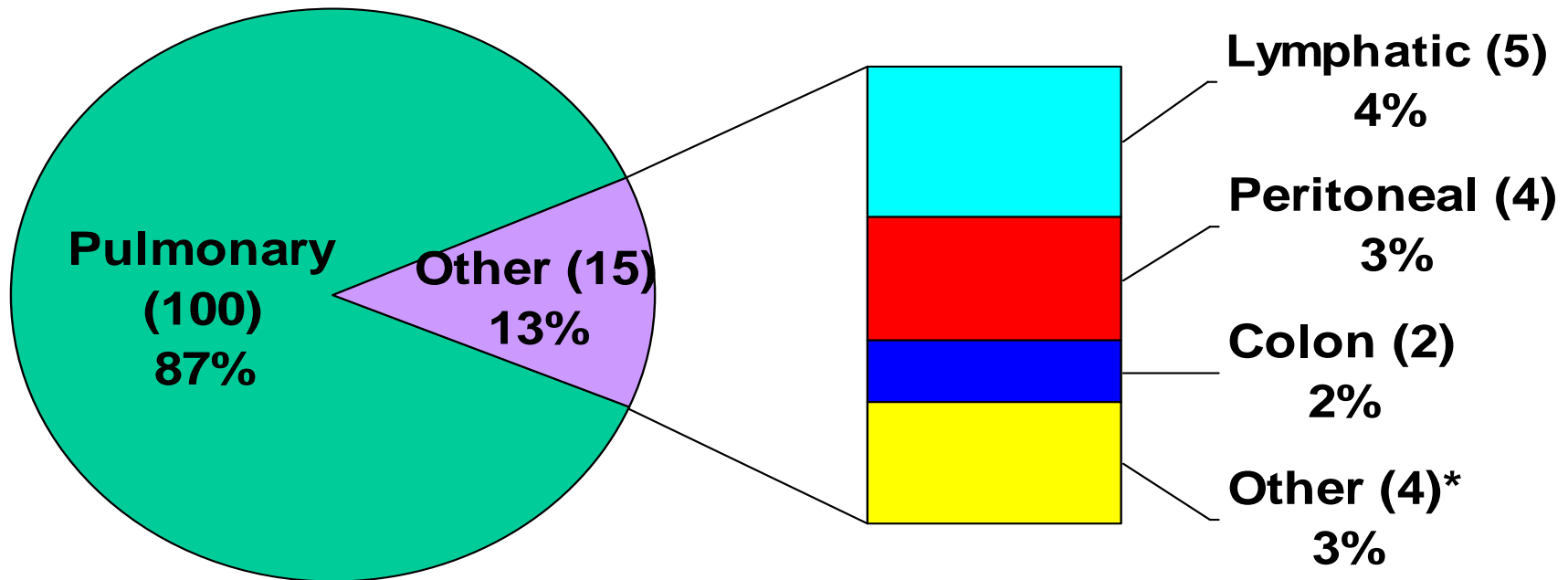

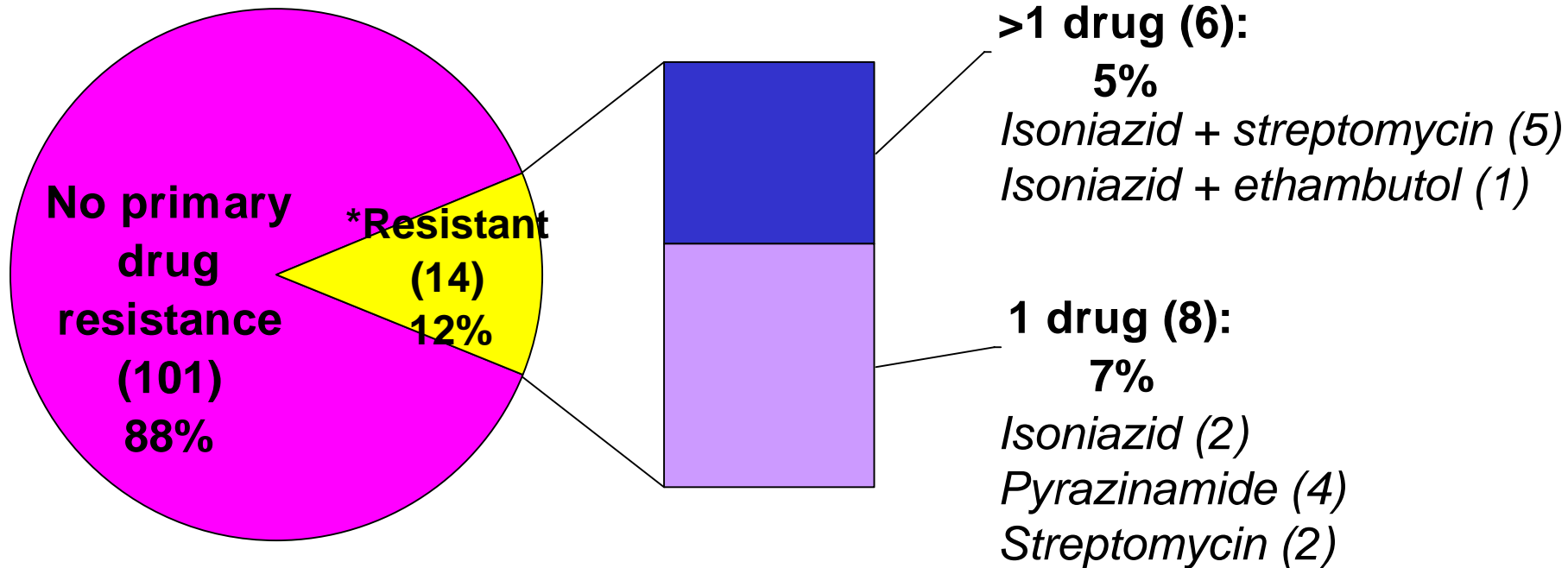

# TB Cases with Primary Drug Resistance\*: Hawai`i, 2006

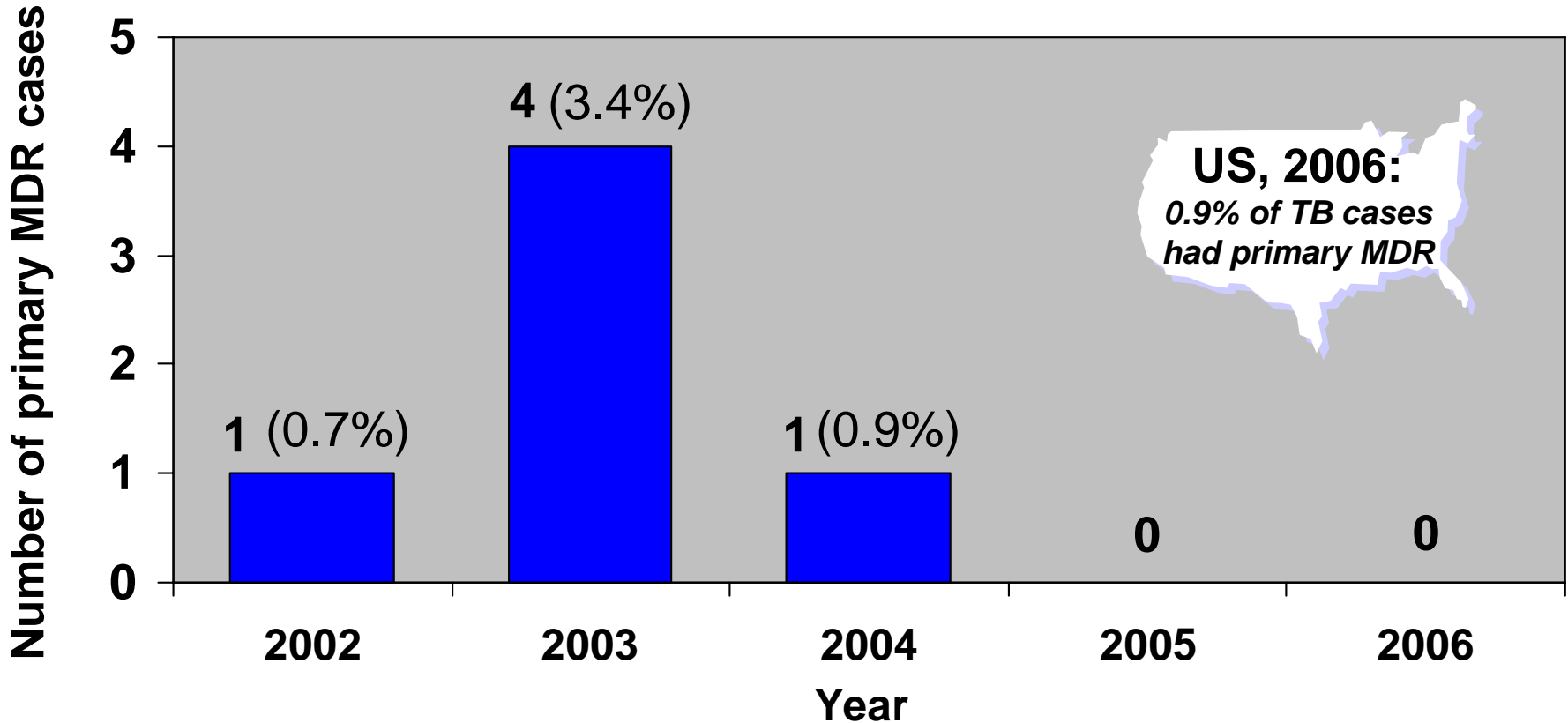

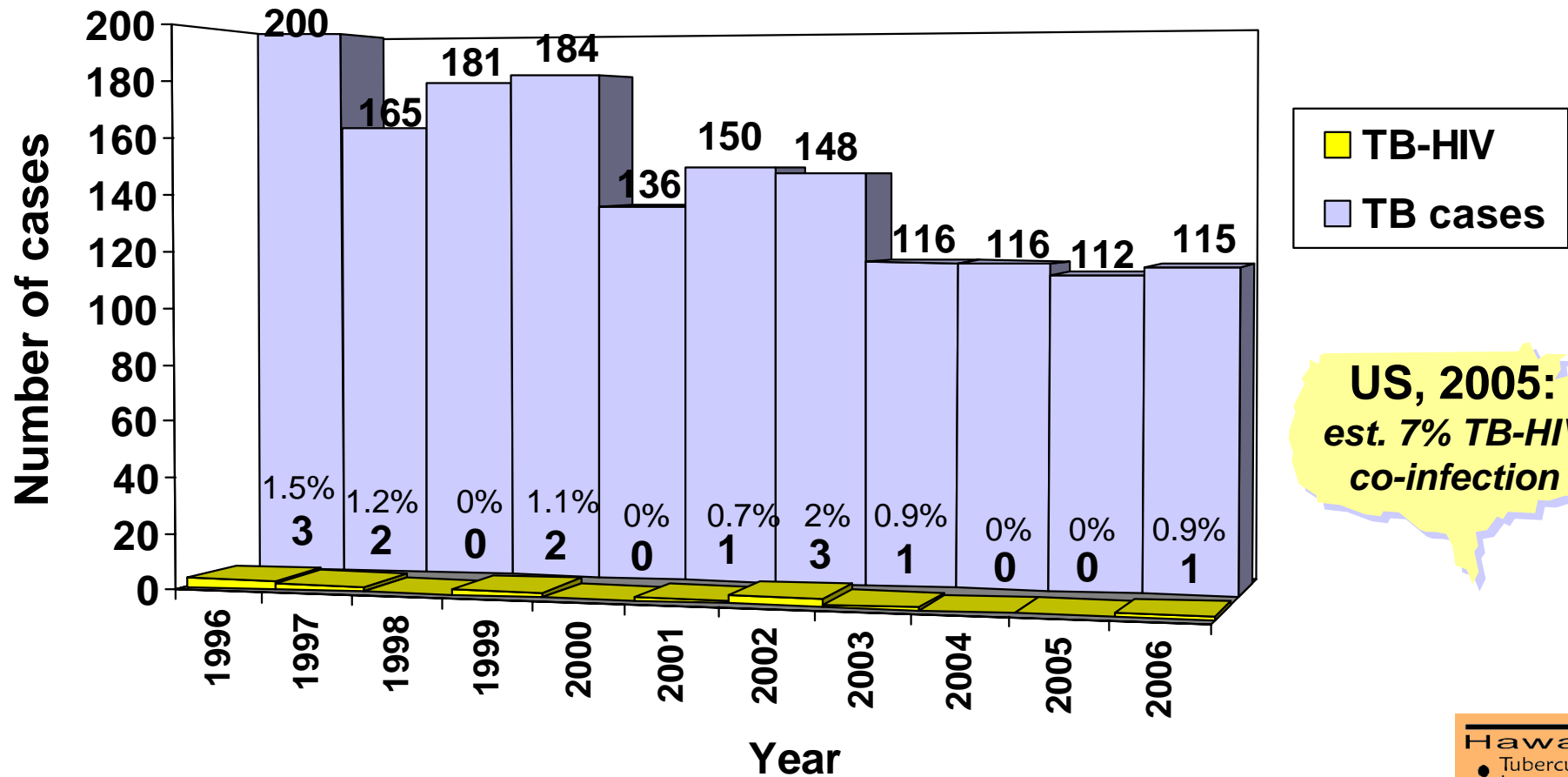
# TB Cases with Primary Multidrug Resistance\*: Hawai`i, 2002 – 2006

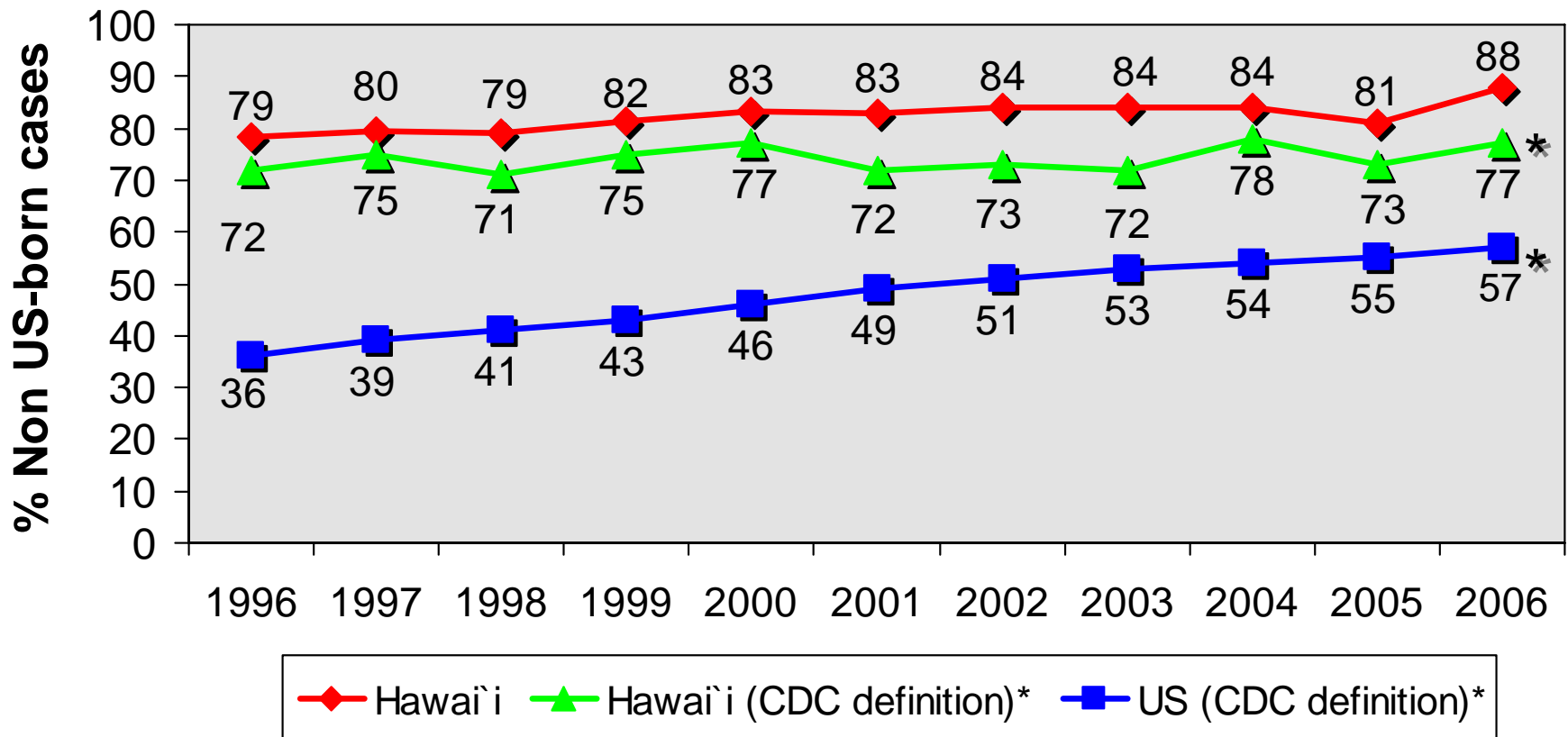
# TB-HIV Co-infected Cases Hawai'i, 1996 - 2006

# Proportion Non US-Born TB Cases Hawai`i vs. US, 1996 - 2006

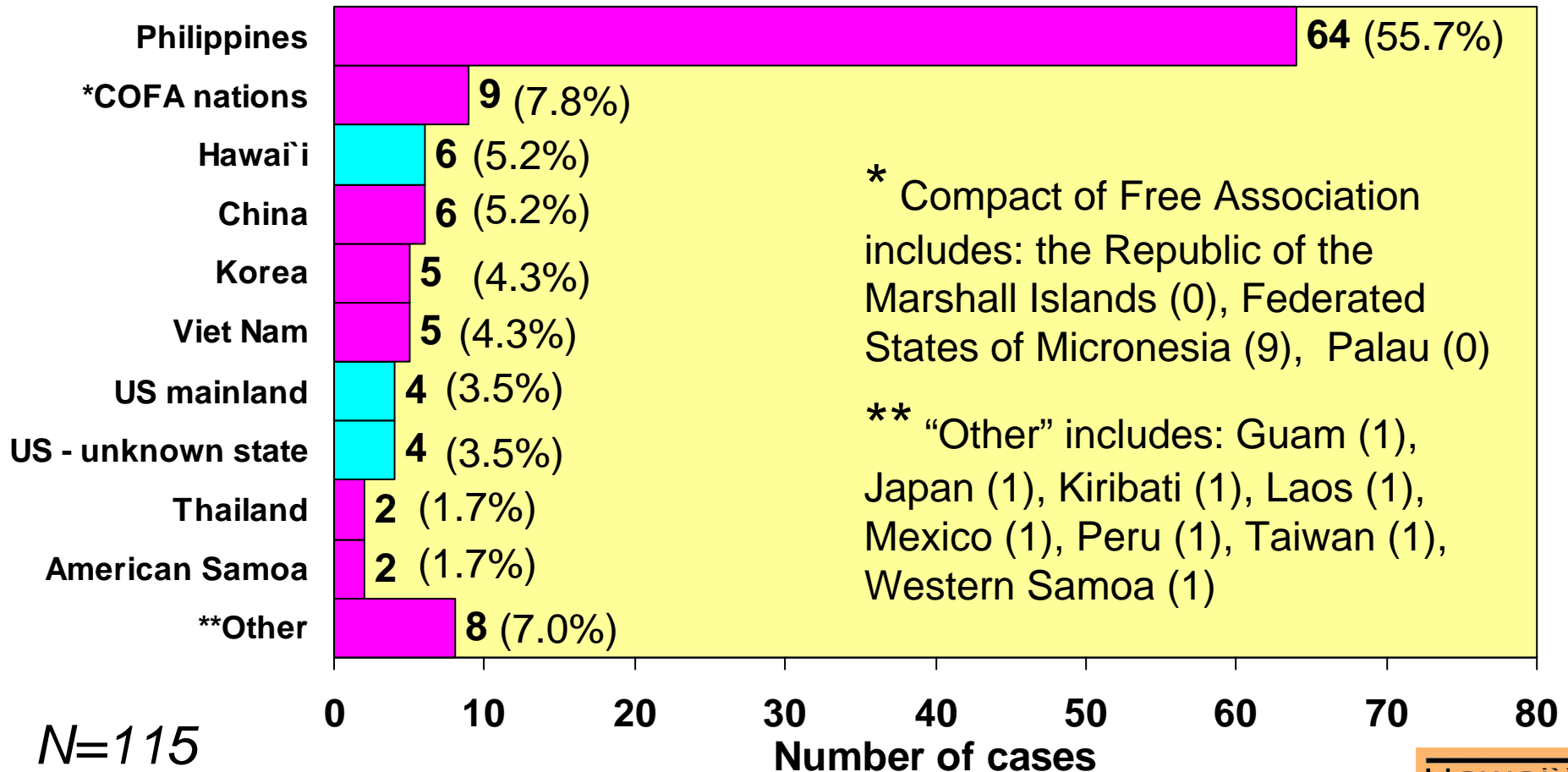

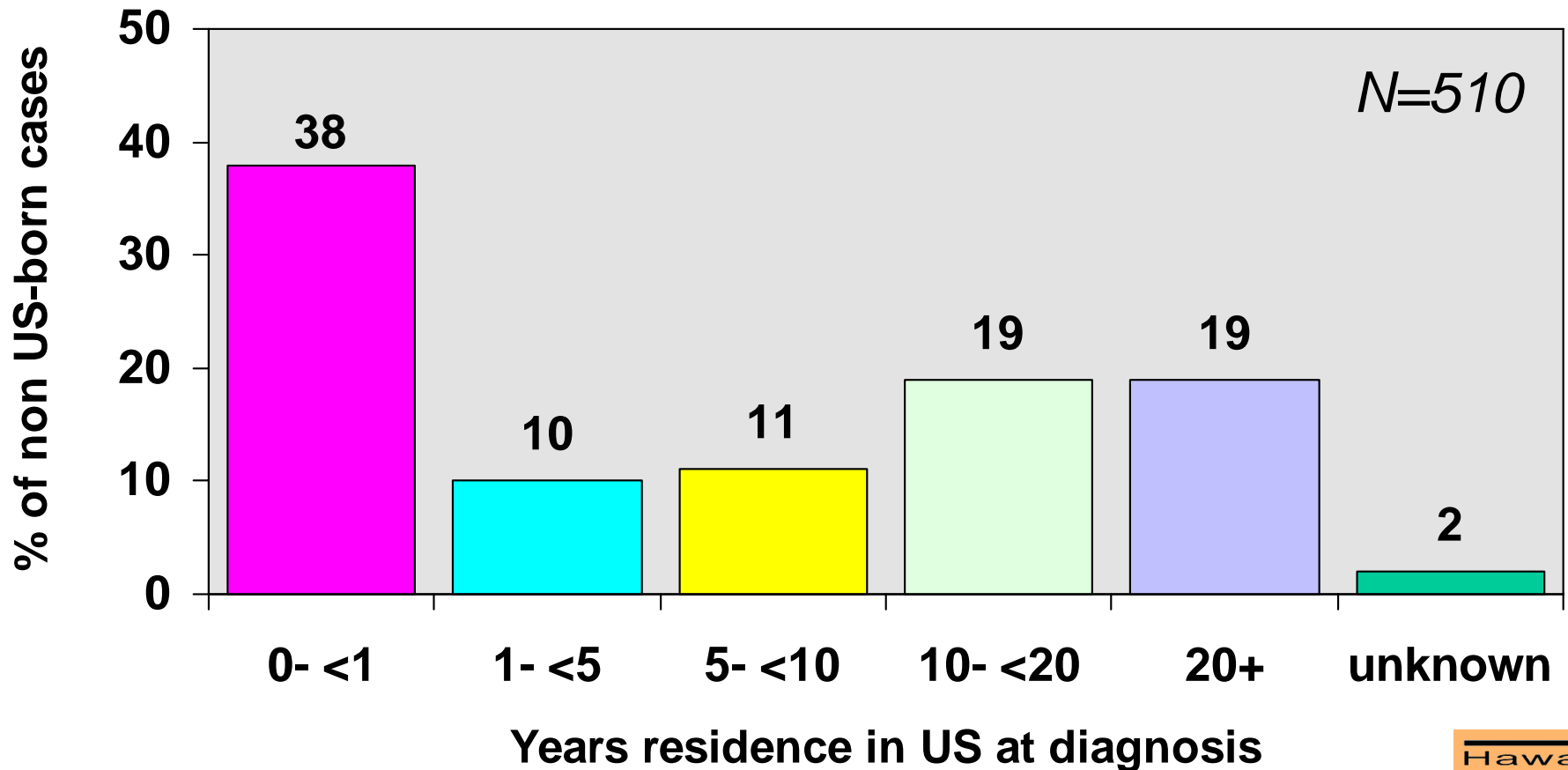
