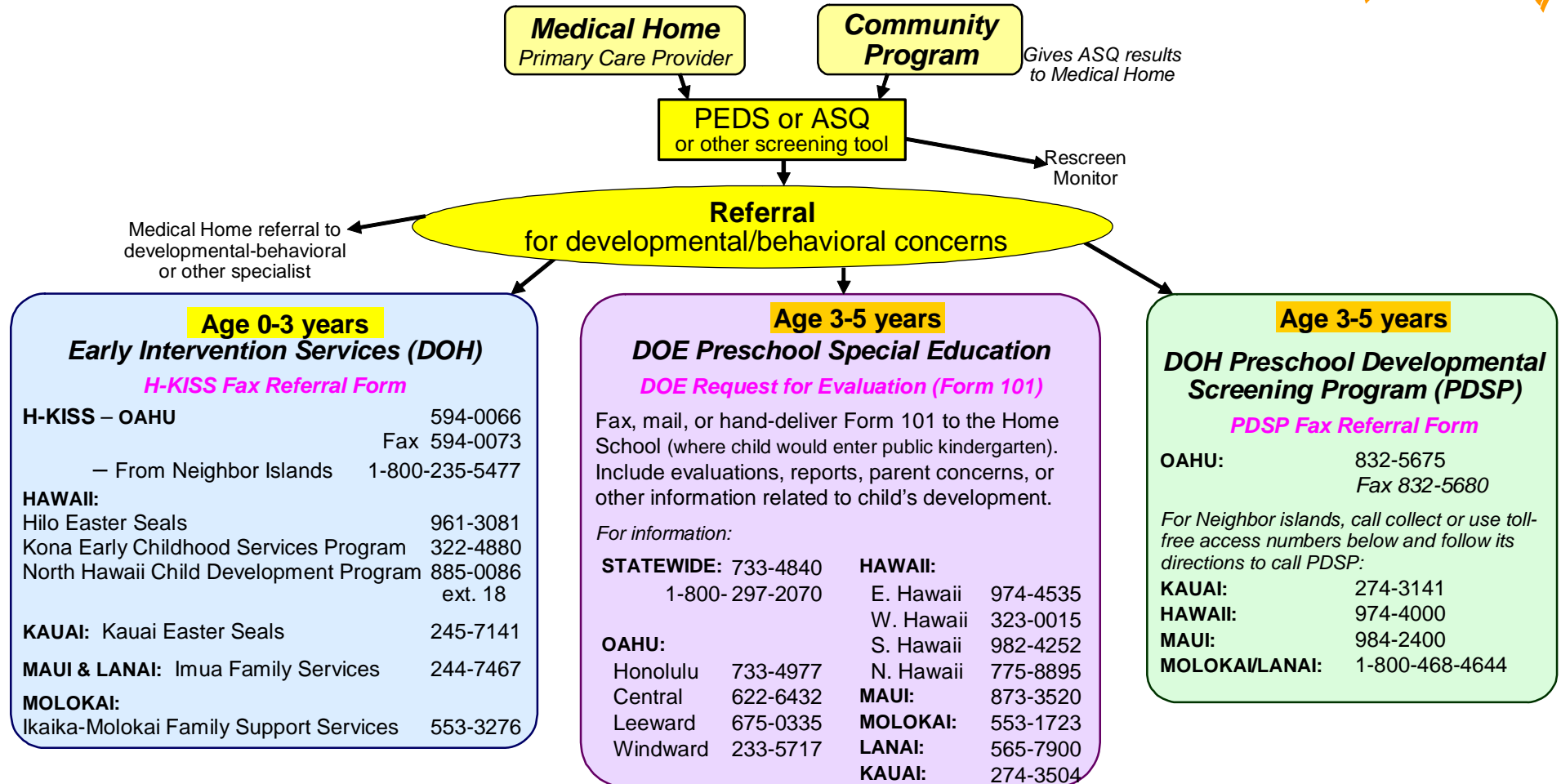


Developmental Screening: A Guide for ASQ and PEDS Referrals for Children Age 0-5 Years



- Early intervention services include:
- Assistive technology (AT)*
 - Audiology
 - Care coordination
 - Family training, counseling, & education
 - Health services
 - Nursing services
 - Nutrition services
 - Occupational therapy
 - Physical therapy
 - Psychological support services
 - Social work
 - Special instruction
 - Speech & language therapy
 - Transportation to EI services
 - Vision services

*AT may have insurance/family cost-sharing.

- Special education is specially designed instruction to meet the unique learning needs of students with disabilities who required Individualized Education Programs. Related services include:
- Speech-language therapy
 - Audiology
 - Psychological services
 - Physical therapy
 - Occupational therapy
 - Counseling services
 - Parent counseling and education

- PDSP services include:
- Developmental screening & rescreening
 - Information to family about activities for child in motor, speech, language, other areas
 - Intervention strategies for early childhood programs & families
 - Referral for speech/language, psychological, or other evaluations
 - Referral to DOE special education
 - Referral to community resources (e.g., Head Start)
 - Referral for speech therapy or private mental health counseling (may have family/insurance costs).
