## Hotel Information

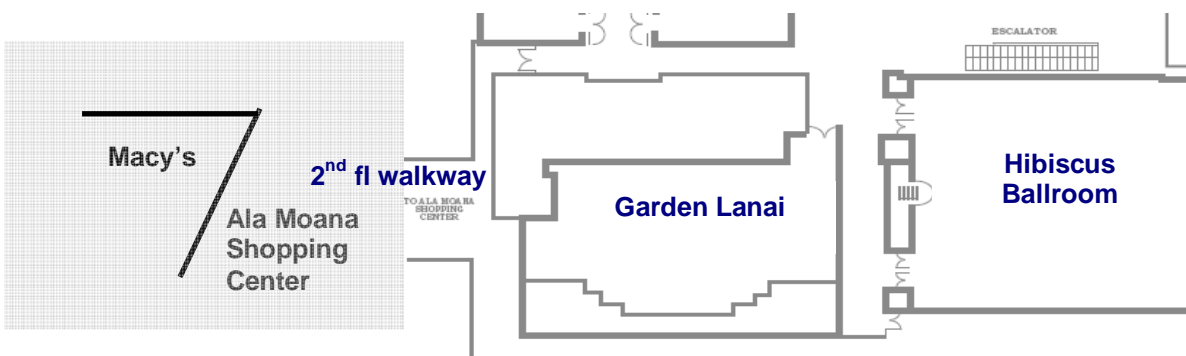
Check-In time: 3:00 pm    Check-Out time: 12:00 noon
