

MANDATORY RELEASE. Please read carefully. I acknowledge and agree that

1. Participation in or attendance at the Prevent Suicide Hawai'i Community Walk (Event) involves inherent risks and dangers of accidents, personal injury (including death), and property loss or damage. These may result from my own actions or inactions, as well as the actions or inactions of others, the rules of the walk, and the conditions of the facilities, equipment and vehicles. Further, there may be other not known to me and not reasonably foreseeable at this time. I have considered the nature and extent of the risks involved and I voluntarily choose to assume all such risks, both known and unknown, even those risks that result from the negligence of the Released Parties (defined below) or others, and assume full responsibility for my participation in the Event. I consent to treatment in the event of an emergency or incident in which, in the reasonable judgment of the on-site personnel, I require medical care.
2. I understand that the Event may be photographed, or otherwise recorded, and I agree that Prevent Suicide Hawai'i may use my name and likeness (in any form and without regard to distortions of character, form or color, or any other alteration) in photographs and other media without any additional consideration to me or to any third party.
3. I, for myself and on behalf of my heirs, estate, insurers, successors and assigns, hereby release indemnify and hold harmless Prevent Suicide Hawai'i its officers directors, employees, agents, and representatives and the successors assigns and insurers of such entities. Kapiolani Park, the City and County of Honolulu, including their Police Department, The Elks Club Waikiki, any owner or lessors of premises used in connection with the Event, and any consultant, sponsor, advertiser, organizer, fiscal agent, or volunteer of the Event (collectively, the Released Parties". With respect to any and all claims or causes of action (including attorney fees). I may have for damages for personal or bodily injury, disability, death, loss or damage to personal property, whether arising from the negligence of any or all of the Released Parties or otherwise, to the fullest extent permitted by law. This release includes claims that may arise during transportation to and from the Event, and I acknowledge that such transportation is solely my responsibility to arrange and obtain.
