## NO GET HURT Hawaii

### Driver Safety Tips:

- Stay alert for sudden pedestrian movement in your car's direction.
- Remember that pedestrians crossing multi-lane streets may be hidden from your view until they cross in front of you.
- Be extra careful when it's dark outside.
- Remember that seniors and children may take longer to cross the street.

### Pedestrian Safety Tips:

- Continue looking both directions while crossing.
- Use crosswalks and look for oncoming vehicles before crossing.
- Wear light-colored clothing or reflective material when it's dark outside.
- Remember that oncoming vehicles may approach quicker than anticipated.
