Data Highlights

❑ Demographics

The growth rate for Kauai between 1998 and 2025 is anticipated to be 50.6% whereas the growth for the state is only expected to be 22.8%.

Kauai County had an older population than the State in 2000 with a median age of 38.4 years vs. the statewide median age of 36.2 years. The Kauai median age has increased at a faster rate than the State median age.

The Kauai ethnic distribution differed more than 5 percentage points from that of the State in 2000 for the following groups:

Ethnicity	Kauai	Statewide
Japanese	15.1%	21.9%
Filipino	23.0%	15.9%
Caucasian	27.0%	21.1%

In 2000, Kauai's resident population density was 105.6 per square mile whereas it was 188.6 statewide.

❑ Social Profile

Whereas 2000 statewide data reported 27% of persons 5 years and older spoke other than English at home, Kauai reported only 20%.

The proportion of female headed households with children under 18 increased more rapidly for Kauai County than for the State from 1990 to 2000.

Over a ten year span, child abuse rates per 1000 children 0-17 years have decreased from 14.8 to 8.7.

❑ Economic Profile

During the early to mid 1990s, the Kauai percentage of unemployed was 6 – 8 percentage points higher than that of the State; however, since 1998, although still higher, the Kauai percentage is now only about 2 percentage points higher.

In 1990, Kauai statistics showed 7.3% in unpaid family 'employment', 6.6% as self-employed, and 14.4% in government employment. Ten years later, in 2000, only .4% remained in unpaid family 'employment' and there was an increase to 10.6% in self-employment and 17.2% in government employment.

In 2000, the Kauai per capita personal income was \$4,539 less than that calculated for the State.

In 1999, the household median income was \$4,800 less than that of the State and the family median income was \$5,583 less.

There was more than a 7 percentage point difference in the number of uninsured Caucasians in 2000 on Kauai compared to the statewide number.

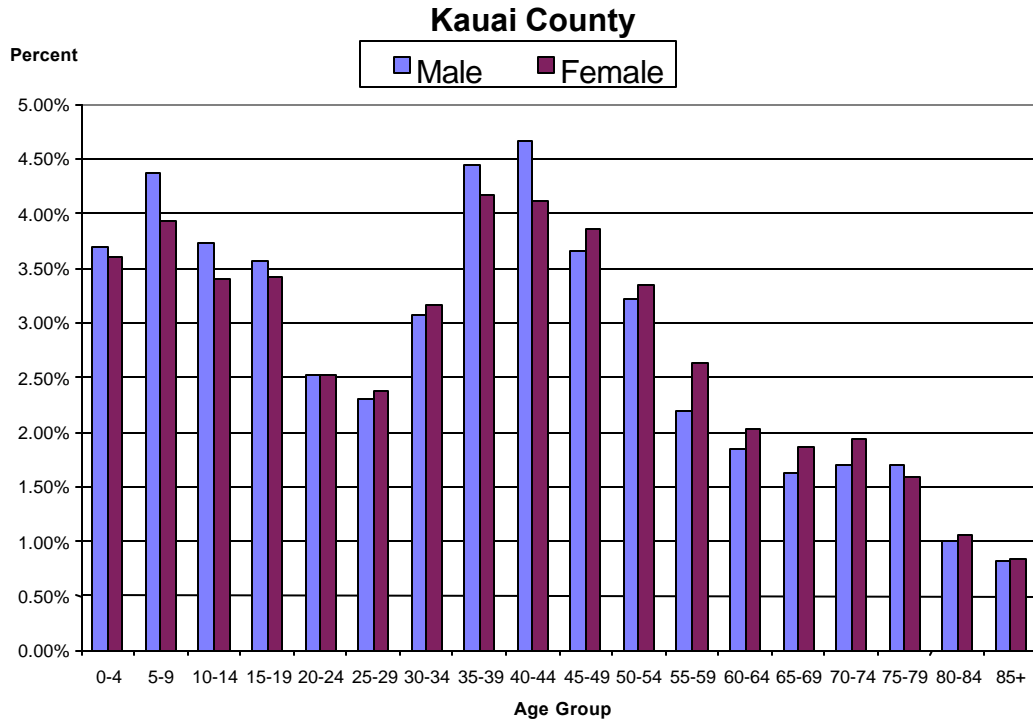
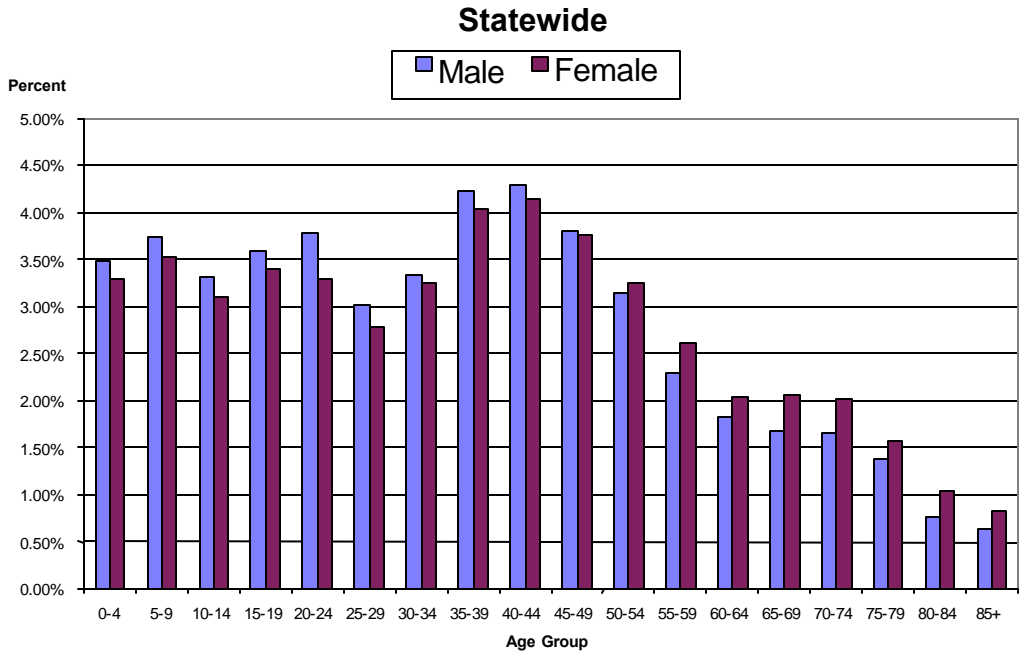
There was a 28% difference in the median value of owned homes in 2000 – State \$272,700 and Kauai \$216,100.

90% of visitors to Kauai in 2000 were from the U.S. compared to 73% statewide.

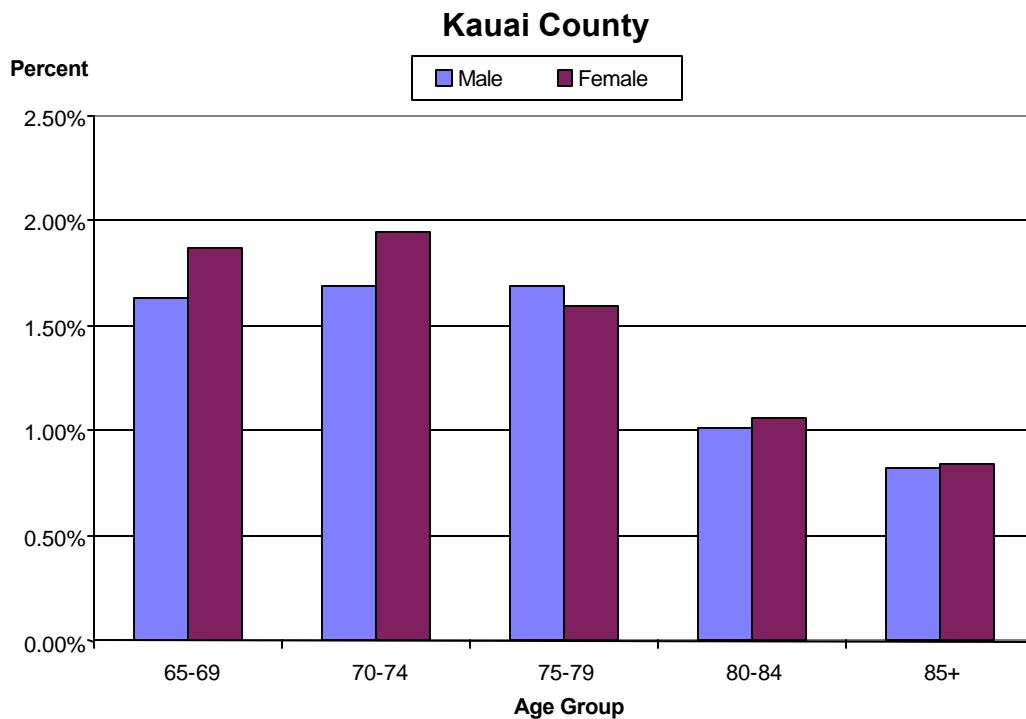
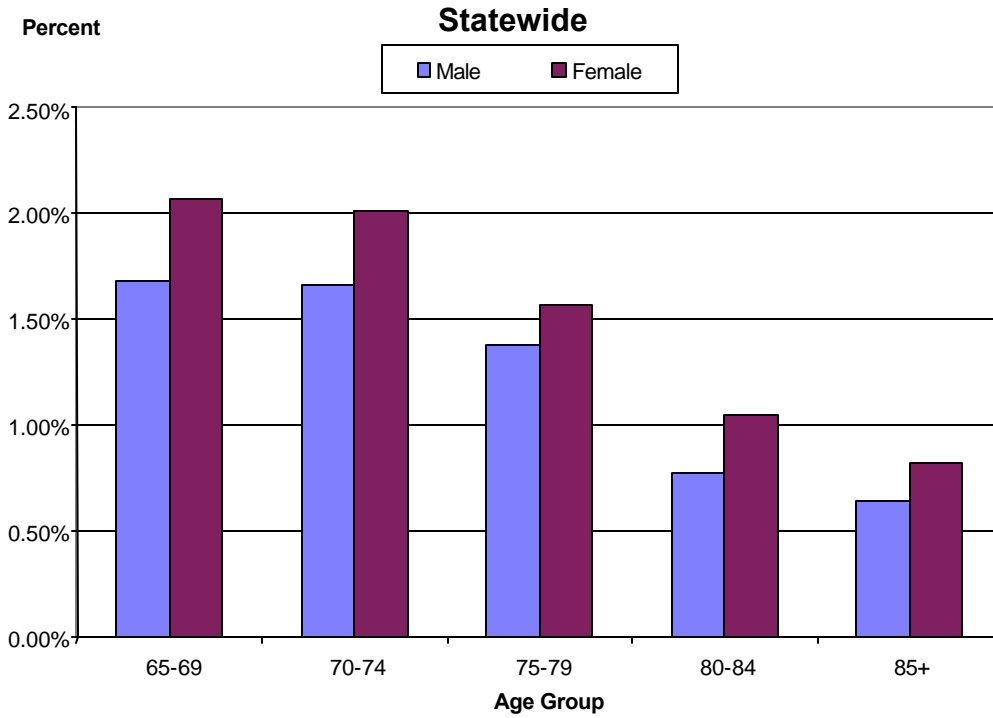

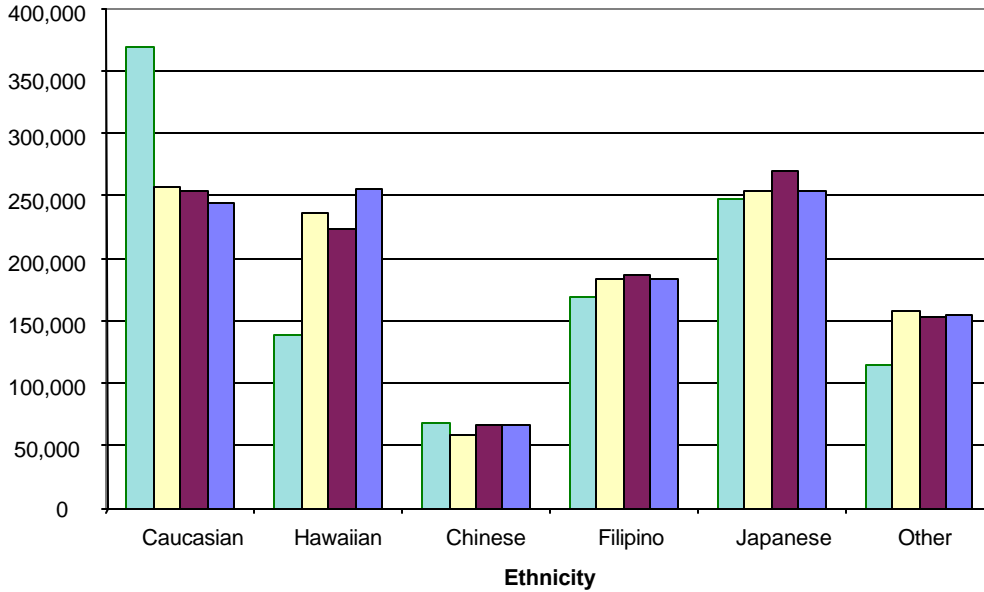

1990-2000

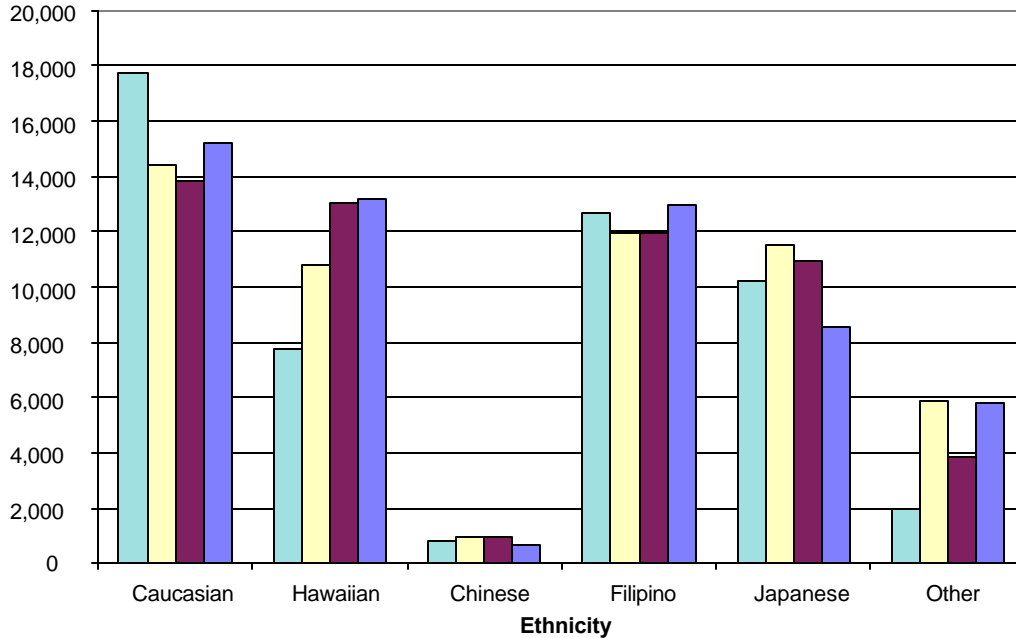
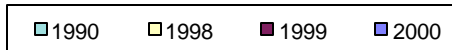

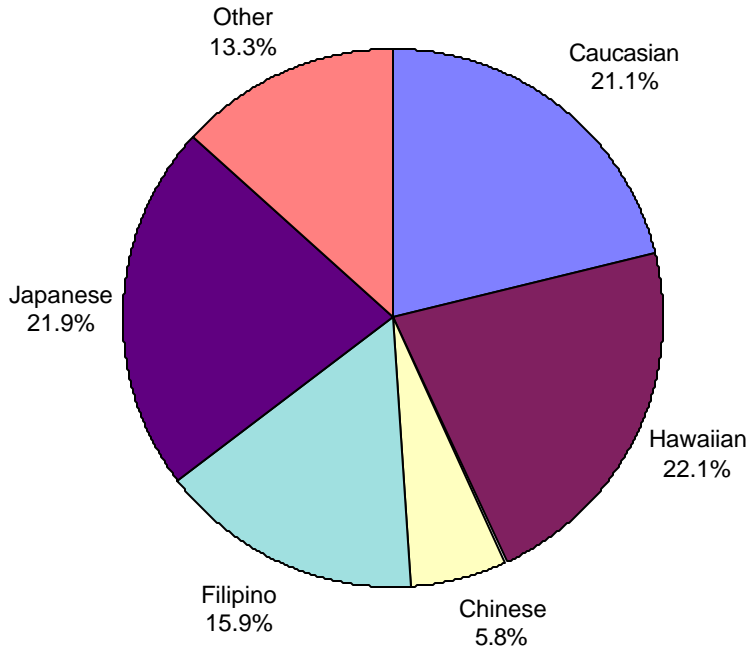

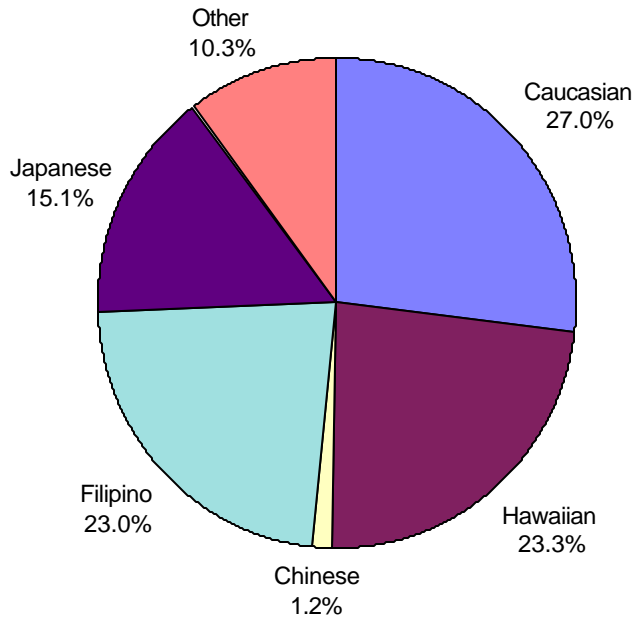

FEMALE HEADED HOUSEHOLDS



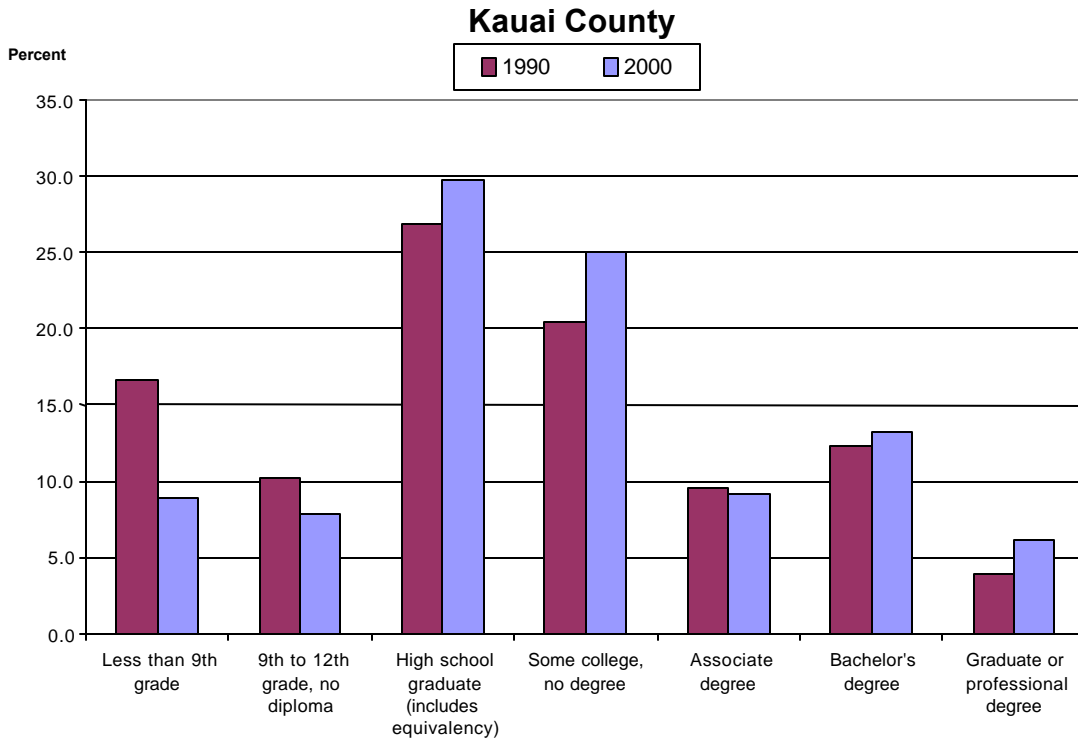
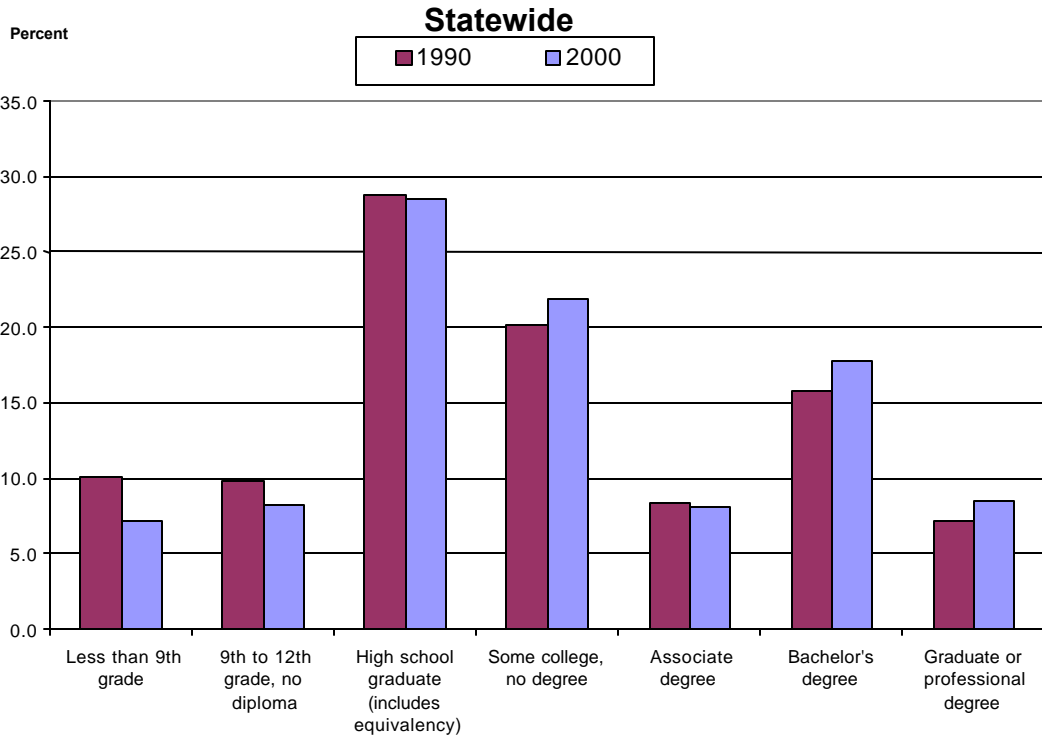

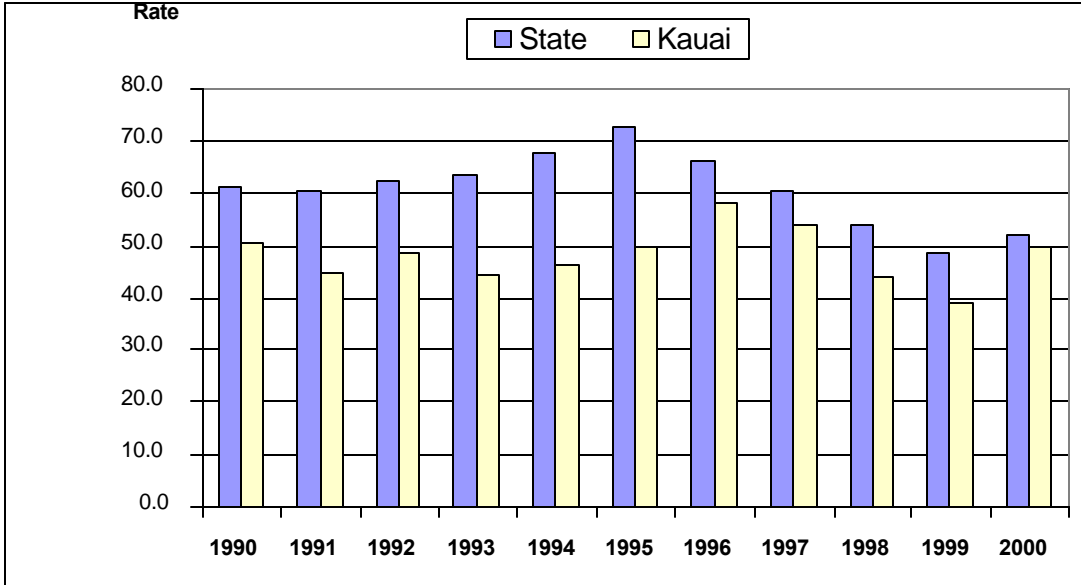

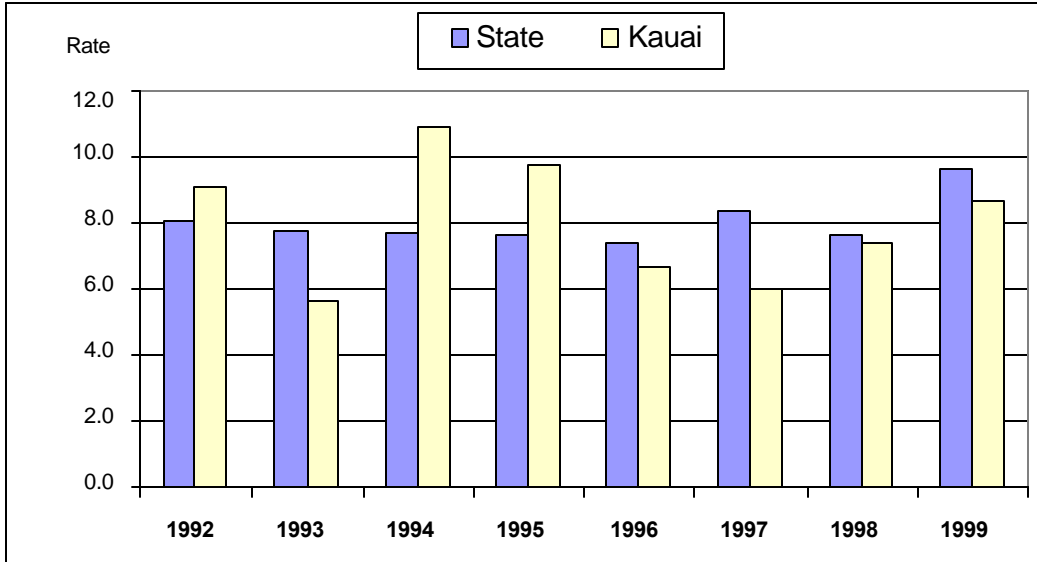

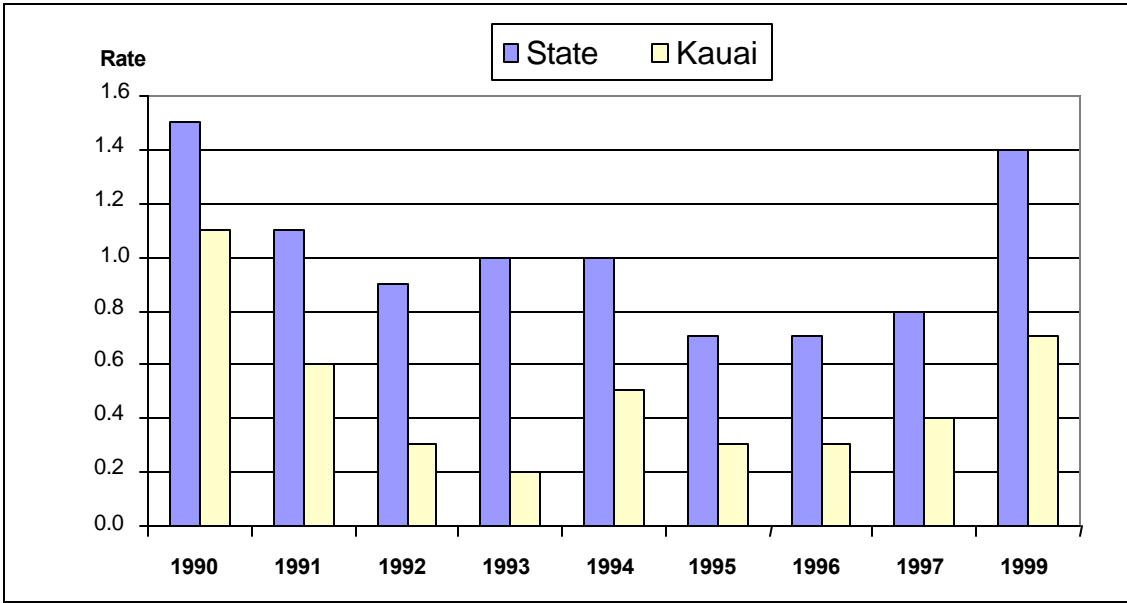

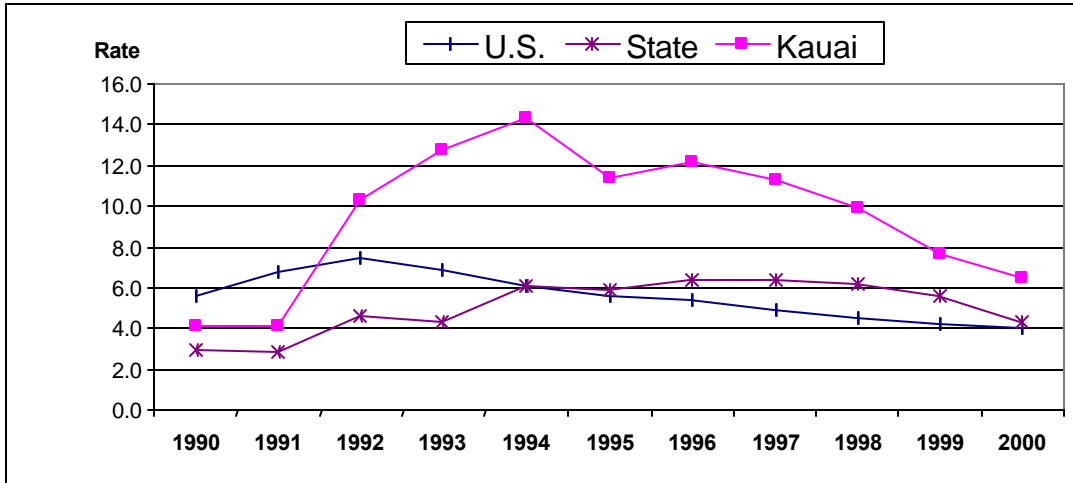

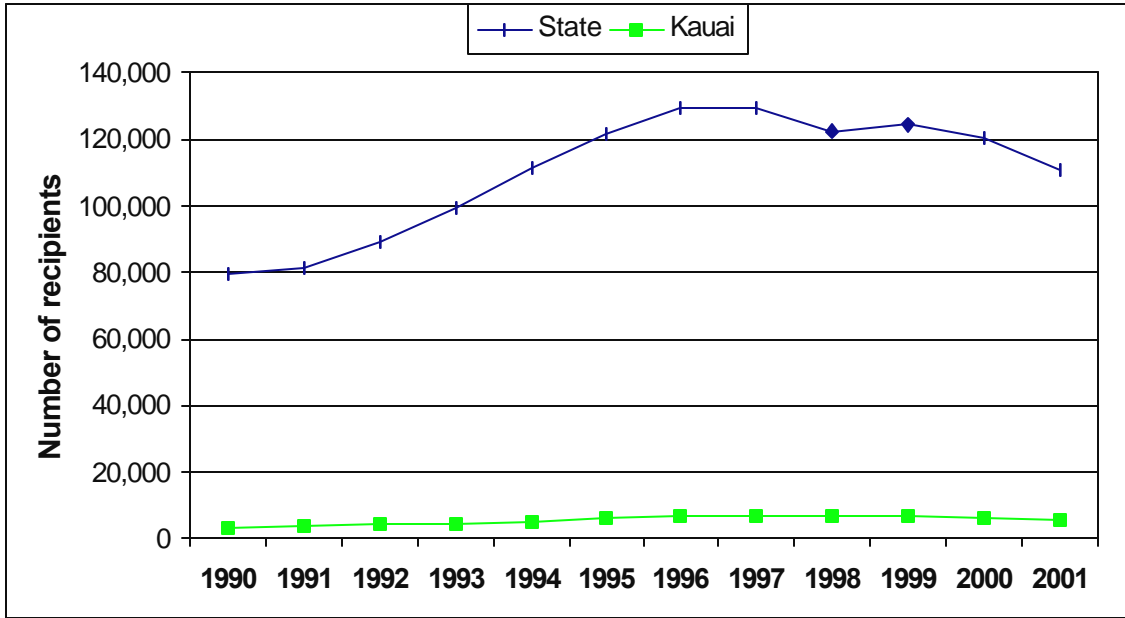

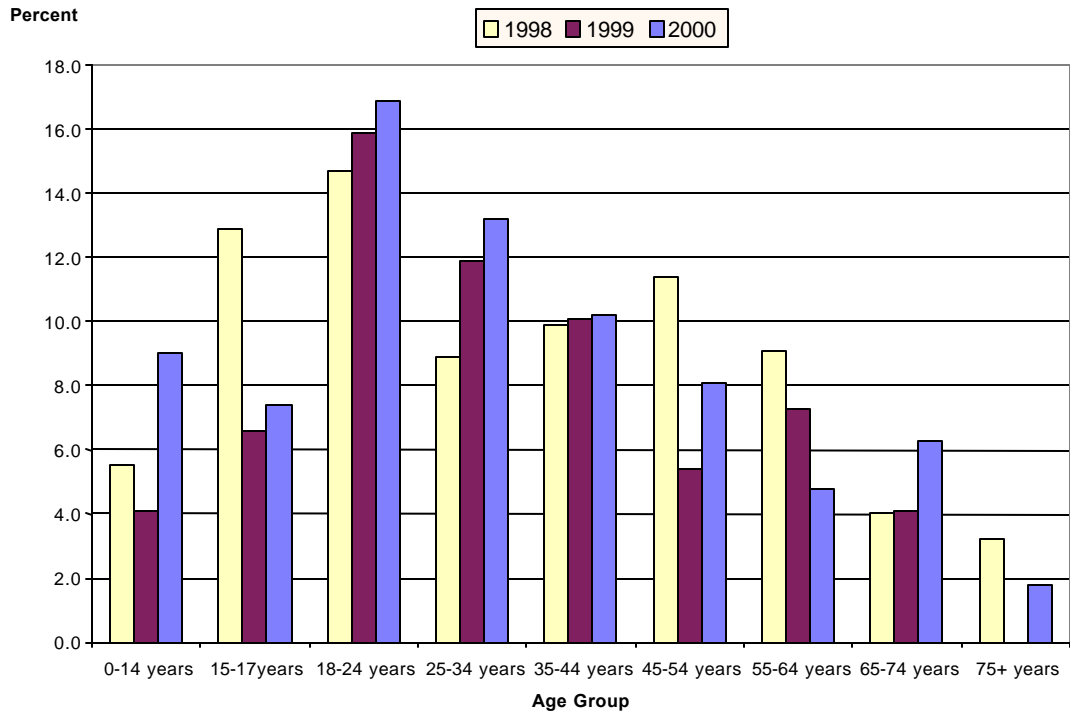
UNINSURED STATUS,
