<p>Asset limits</p> <p>For households qualifying under Regular SNAP, assets include cash, savings, checking, stocks, bonds, other real property not lived on, etc. <i>The home you live in and vehicles you own are not considered when determining eligibility.</i></p>	<p>\$2,000 for all households except for aged or disabled</p> <p>\$3,000 if aged (60 and older) or if totally disabled persons live in the home.</p> <p>Resources not counted under BBCE</p>	<p>\$5,000 for a family with minor children (under age 19)</p> <p>\$3,000 for a married couple without minor children</p> <p>\$2,000 for a single person</p>
<p>Maximum monthly benefits</p> <p>Countable income will reduce the amount of benefits a household receives</p>	<p>1 person: \$314 5 persons: \$1243</p> <p>2 persons: \$575 6 persons: \$1491</p> <p>3 persons: \$824 7 persons: \$1648</p> <p>4 persons: \$1046 8 persons: \$1884</p>	<p>For families: 5 persons: \$1076</p> <p>1 person: \$450 6 persons: \$1232</p> <p>2 persons: \$607 7 persons: \$1389</p> <p>3 persons: \$763 8 persons: \$1545</p> <p>4 persons: \$919</p>
<p>Who must be included in the household?</p>	<p>1. All persons who eat and purchase food together in the same home must apply together.</p> <p>2. Children under the age of 22 who live with their parents must apply with their parents.</p>	<p>1. Families with minor related children.</p> <p>2. An adult or married couple without minor children, who is 65 years of age or older, legally blind, or disabled. When disabled, certification of disability will be required.</p>
<p>Other requirements</p>	<p>1. Must meet work requirements if has child over age 6 or if receiving financial assistance and has child over 6 months.</p> <p>2. May be exempt from work requirements if receiving SNAP only and is employed full-time, disabled etc.</p>	<p>Each type of assistance will have additional program requirements, such as work, child/spousal support, treatment provisions, time limits, etc.</p>
