SAMUEL MAHELONA MEMORIAL HOSPITAL, Kapa'a

SMMH is situated in quiet, picturesque Kapa'a, a former plantation town on Kauai's scenic Coconut Coast. Licensed beds: 80 (66 SNF/ICF, 9 psychiatric, & 5 acute/SNF) Employees: 145 Services: Acute/emergent, skilled and intermediate nursing care, psychiatric services, tuberculosis services and outpatient services that include laboratory, radiology and physical and occupational therapy.

KAUAI VETERANS MEMORIAL HOSPITAL, Waimea

Dedicated to the Veterans of the Korean War, KVMH opened in 1957 to provide hospital and clinic care to residents of historic Waimea and neighboring communities. Licensed beds: 45 beds (15 acute care, 20 SNF & 10 SNF/ICF) Employees: 218 Services: 24-hour emergency room, acute, ICU/CCU, OB, skilled nursing care, multiple outpatient clinics, outpatient radiology, laboratory, and respiratory, occupational and physical therapies.

O'AHU REGION

LEAHI HOSPITAL, Honolulu

Established in 1900, Leahi is located on the foothills adjacent to famous Diamond Head and Waikiki Beach. Licensed beds: 192 licensed beds (179 dual ICF/SNF & 13 tuberculosis) Employees: 375 Services: Treatment of tuberculosis and skilled and intermediate nursing care.

MAUI MEMORIAL MEDICAL CENTER, Wailuku

HHSC's largest acute care facility on one of the world's most popular vacation destinations. MMC is centrally located in the heart of the two major towns, Wailuku and Kahului. Licensed beds: 196 (140 medical/surgical, 15 critical care [ICU/CCU], 23 OB, and 18 psychiatric beds [7 adolescent]) Employees: 831 Services: Emergency room, surgery, obstetrics, nursing, medical, pediatric, ICU/CCU, nuclear medicine, angiography, MRI, CT scanning and ultrasound.

KULA HOSPITAL, Kula

Located in cool, quiet upcountry Maui, stately Kula Hospital overlooks stunning ocean and mountain vistas. Licensed beds: 115 (104 SNF/ICF, 2 acute & 9 for developmentally disabled). Employees: 198

LANAI COMMUNITY HOSPITAL, Lanai City

The island's only hospital, LCH provides acute and long-term care to residents and visitors of this former pineapple plantation, now a popular and peaceful retreat for travelers. Licensed beds: 14 (6 general acute and 8 SNF/ICF) Employees: 23 Services: Acute care, skilled nursing, obstetrics, emergency room and ambulance service.

KONA COMMUNITY HOSPITAL, Kealahou

Serving a growing West Hawaii community, KCH lies above historic Kailua-Kona, a sunny mecca for sportsfishing, water sports and sightseeing. HILO MEDICAL CENTER, Hilo

Combining acute and long-term care, HMC is HHSC's largest facility and is located in historic Hilo near ocean recreation, waterfalls, gardens and a restored downtown district. Licensed beds: 275 (143 general, 20 psychiatric & 112 long-term care) Employees: 900 Services: Surgery, obstetrics, pediatrics, home care, radiology, pathology and laboratory, respiratory therapy, rehabilitation services, oncology and emergency room service.

HALE HO'OLA HAMAKUA, Honokaa

Serving the Big Island's Hamakua, North Hilo, South Kohala and Waikoloa Districts, this Critical Access Hospital is situated in quaint Honokaa, a former sugarcane plantation town. Licensed beds: 50 Employees: 94 Services: Occupational, physical and speech therapy, skilled nursing and intermediate care, limited acute care, emergency room services and limited radiology.

KA'U HOSPITAL, Pahala

Situated about 25 miles beyond Volcanoes National Park, Ka'u Hospital cares for residents of this vast rural region known for pristine coastal vistas, macadamia nut farms and home to black sand beaches.
