

OSHA Training for Contractors on ARRA/Stimulus Funded Projects

If you are or will be a contractor on an ARRA/Stimulus funded jobsite, you **WILL** be inspected by inspectors from the Hawai'i Occupational Safety and Health Division (HIOSH) – even if you are working on a Federal property/project. Federal OSHA has mandated that HIOSH inspect 100% of all jobsites receiving federal stimulus funds. Make sure you're prepared!
