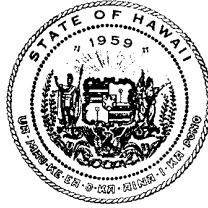

#### Call to order

Chair Vendetta established a quorum and called the meeting to order at 9:05 am.

#### Minutes of May 13, 2009

#### Compliance Branch Report

No hoisting crane accidents were reported. Board members asked Jamesner Dumlao to include in future branch reports any non-compliance citations for crane operators.

#### Old Business

##### Administrative Rules and Statute

Director Ching is currently working on protocols and guidelines for enforcing certification denials. The rules will establish guidelines for denials case by case basis. Discussion ensued on whether crane operator's should have yearly updates on drug and accidents. Discussions will continue at the next board meeting.

Under 12-48-3 Definitions, "ASME B30.5-2000, AG Lam will check and confirm if it is possible to include automatically in the statutes updated new versions each year.

### Using Certification Fees for Crane Operator's Training

Fees can only be used for operating expenses, necessary board costs and reimbursements it's executive director. These expenses include preparation and dissemination of public information on certification and training. The fees cannot be used to pay for training.

### Reducing Current Certification Fees

Certification fees have not varied for eight years. After reimbursing the state for legal costs and operating expenses, the fund may be self sufficient as intended. Jamesner Dumlao will request an update of the budget and its expenses from Francis Kagawa.
