

Hawaii Workforce Informer (**HIWI**) is now available to assist jobseekers and employers. **HIWI** is an interactive website launched by the Research and Statistics Office of the Hawaii State Department of Labor and Industrial Relations. Job search, career information, area labor market information, wages, employment projections, economic indicators and employer information are offered at the HIWI website. The best

features of the site - users can access data from a database, create and view their own data extracts, and export the data to their desktops. Results may even be saved to a personalized web page, **My HIWI**.

# FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS



*What is Labor Market Information?*

Labor Market Information is data that describes the economic conditions in a certain geographical area. Information about population, labor force, employment and unemployment rates, income, property values, education and training providers, and more can all be included under the heading of "labor market information". **HIWI** makes available such information for the state and counties when users select the tab **Labor Market Info** on the upper-right horizontal navigation bar.

*How often are data updated on HIWI?*

**HIWI** is updated as new data becomes available. Data may be updated monthly, quarterly, or annually depending on the source releasing the data type.

*Does HIWI offer career and job search information?*

The **Career Center** at **HIWI** is a great place to find information you need if you are looking for a job, wanting to switch careers, or helping individuals with career choices. You can quickly find information for many occupations and save your results for later use.

**HIWI** makes it easy to find information on wages, occupational employment projections, licensing and education requirements, job skills, and even job openings in your area. Take the **Career Center** tour to find out how you can use this tool to your advantage. Select the tab Career Center on the upper-right horizontal navigation bar.

*Can data be downloaded from the HIWI website?*

Data can be easily downloaded from the site. The **Download Data Tables** tool allows users to access data from our core labor market information database. They can create and view their own data, then download to their personal computers for further manipulation and analysis. Select **Download Data Tables** from the upper-right horizontal navigation bar.

*Does HIWI have wage information for a specific occupation?*

**HIWI** is the primary source of occupational wage information provided in "Wages by Occupation" under the **Download Data Tables** tab on the horizontal navigation bar.

*Where can I find information for Affirmative Action planning on HIWI?*

Information is available to assist employers in their preparation of an Affirmative Action Program (AAP). An update of labor force estimates for the year 2003 and occupational data by sex and race from Census 2000 are available on the Business page in **HIWI**. (A link to the Business page is at the left navigation bar.) Data is not comparable to previous Census reports due to separate and multiple race categories.
