§12-148.1-1 Incorporation of federal standard. Title 29, Code of Federal Regulations, section 1926.62, entitled "Lead", published by the Office of the Federal Register, National Archives and Records Administration, on May 4, 1993, and the amendments as published on June 24, 1993; and January 8, 1998, is made a part of this chapter, except as provided in section 12-148.1-2.
