**§12-203.1-1 Incorporation of federal standard.** Title 29, Code of Federal Regulations, section 1910.1200, entitled "Hazard Communication", published by the Office of the Federal Register, National Archives and Records Administration, on February 9, 1994, and the amendments published on December 22, 1994 and March 7, 1996, are made a part of this chapter, except as provided in section 12-203.1-2. **§12-203.1-2 Definitions.** As used in 29 CFR 1910.1200 and applied to this chapter:

"29 CFR part 1910, subpart Z" means chapter 12-202.

"29 CFR 1910.20" means section 12-202-3.

"Act" means chapter 396, Hawaii Revised Statutes.

"Assistant Secretary" means the director, department of labor and industrial relations or the director's designee.

"Effective dates" means September 11, 1994.

"Occupational Safety and Health Review Commission" means the department of labor and industrial relations appeals board.
