

## REVENUE TRENDS – OCTOBER 2005

Total tax revenue for the month of October was \$370.2 million. For the first four months of the 2006 fiscal year, collections are up 16.6% over the same FY2005 time period.

October 2005 general excise and use taxes totaled \$192.1 million. Fiscal year-to-date general excise and use tax revenues have grown by 17.4%.

Transient accommodations tax (TAT) collections amounted to \$14.4 million for the month, and are up by 6.2% for FY2006.

For October, individual income tax receipts were \$102.7 million, contributing to a 7.4% growth rate for the current fiscal year.

Fuel taxes were \$13.2 million, and public service company receipts added \$8.7million to October's total.

## STATE GENERAL FUND

From October 2005 tax collections, \$322.1 million was deposited into the state general fund. For the first four months of FY2006, general fund deposits are up 17.2% over the same period of FY2005.
